Over the years, wildlife conservation has grown in Kruger and is evidenced in plans to extend its boundaries. Kruger National Park's world fame is attributed to its untouched beauty and its unrivalled wildlife population. Enjoy two nights in the park at the 4 – star Royal Kruger Lodge.

Steeped in Settler history, and dating back to the time when a multitude of game roamed wild and free, the 20 000 hectare reserve boasts five eco-systems, thus enabling the support of many forms of plant, animal and bird life. This is the ultimate African adventure and conservation effort coupled with responsible tourism. Choose from one of the lodges below.

Bushmans River Lodge is a beautifully restored Victorian homestead. The home – from – home atmosphere is a welcoming reminder of true South African hospitality. The Arabella Golf Club puts professional golfers to the test and at the same time is playable for the average hacker. The fairways are wide and spacious. Both fairways and greens are in an exceptionally good condition.

Choosing a signature hole is tough as the 9th, 17th and the 18th all run parallel to the lagoon. As a result the par-three had been chosen. This hole requires a precise tee shot (If you miss the green to the right, you might find yourself on the beach!)

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport a representative will be waiting to answer any questions. The drive to the Western Cape Hotel and Spa passed great scenic beauty. The Western Cape Hotel & Spa, set in the premises of the Arabella Country Estate, offers the golf experience of a lifetime. A round on either Fancourt's Outeniqua and Montagu golf courses is a special experience, sculpted and finished as they are with rare attention to detail and designed with the coastal George winds in mind.

The Links at Fancourt was added in 2000, an awe – Inspiring example of magnificent design and golf course construction. The Greater St. Lucia Wetland World Heritage site offers a diverse collection ecosystems and variety of vegetation types which support the greatest variety of birds in the country. VICTORIA FALLS

The Victoria Falls is 1 708 meters wide, making it the largest curtain of water in the world. It drops between 90m and 107m into the Zambezi Gorge. Victoria Falls constitutes one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world. The Local people call it "Mosi-oa-Tunya" -- the smoke that thunders. Enjoy two nights at either the Zambezi Sun or Royal Livingstone.

Day 1: *Having been met by the representative on arrival at Livingstone Airport, a transfer will follow to the hotel. Enjoy a late afternoon sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi River and overnight at either Zambezi Sun or Royal Livingstone.*

Day 2: *After breakfast enjoy a guided tour of the Victoria Falls, one of the seven natural wonders of the world. With a height twice that of Niagara Falls and width of 5,600 feet, the falls have the capacity to push 150 million gallons of water per minute over the mile-wide basalt cliff.
