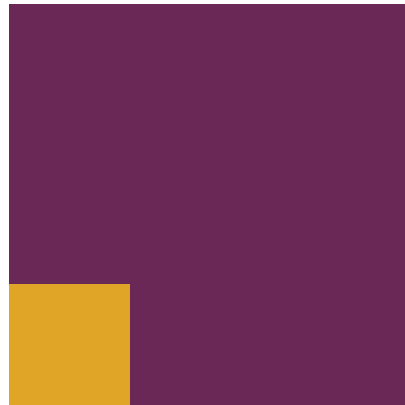

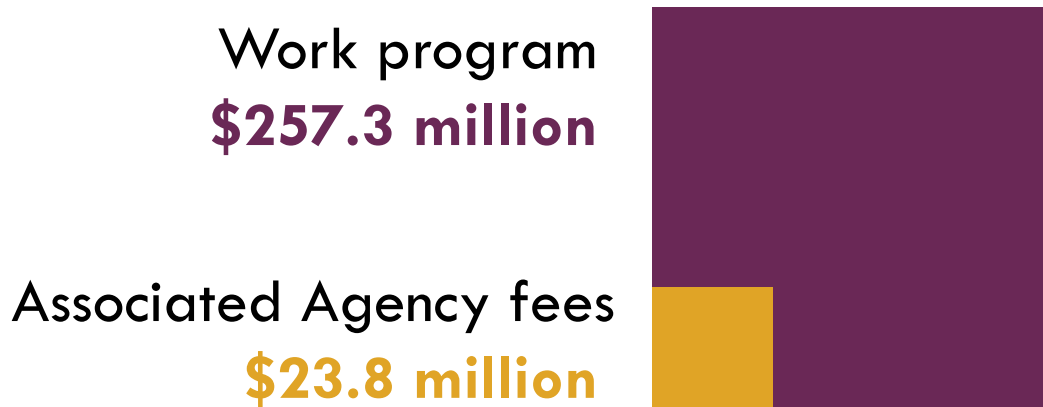

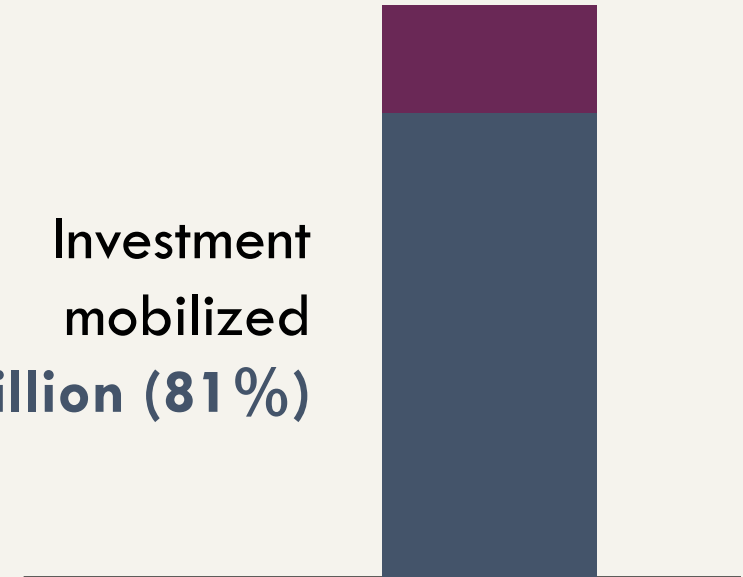

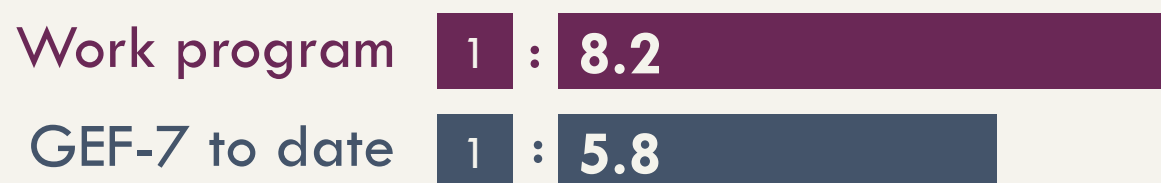

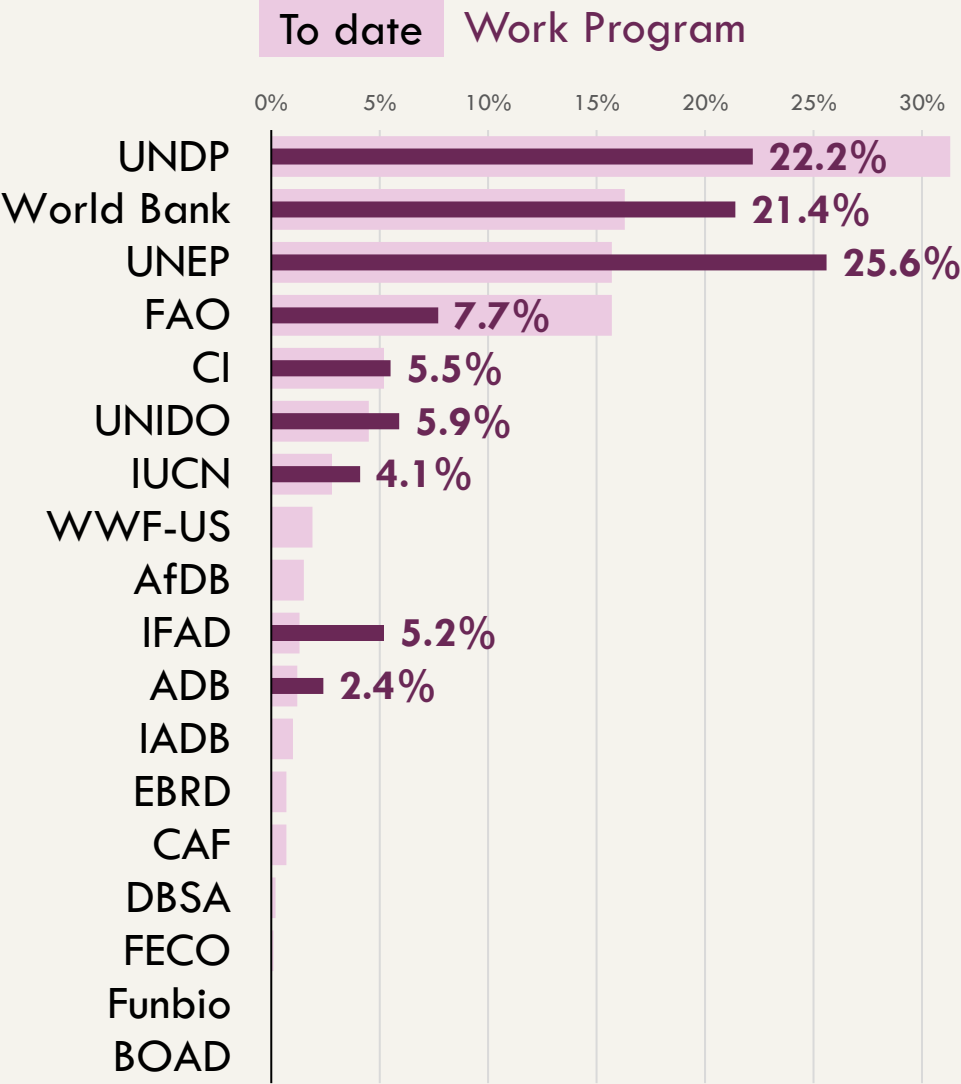
Co-financing ratio



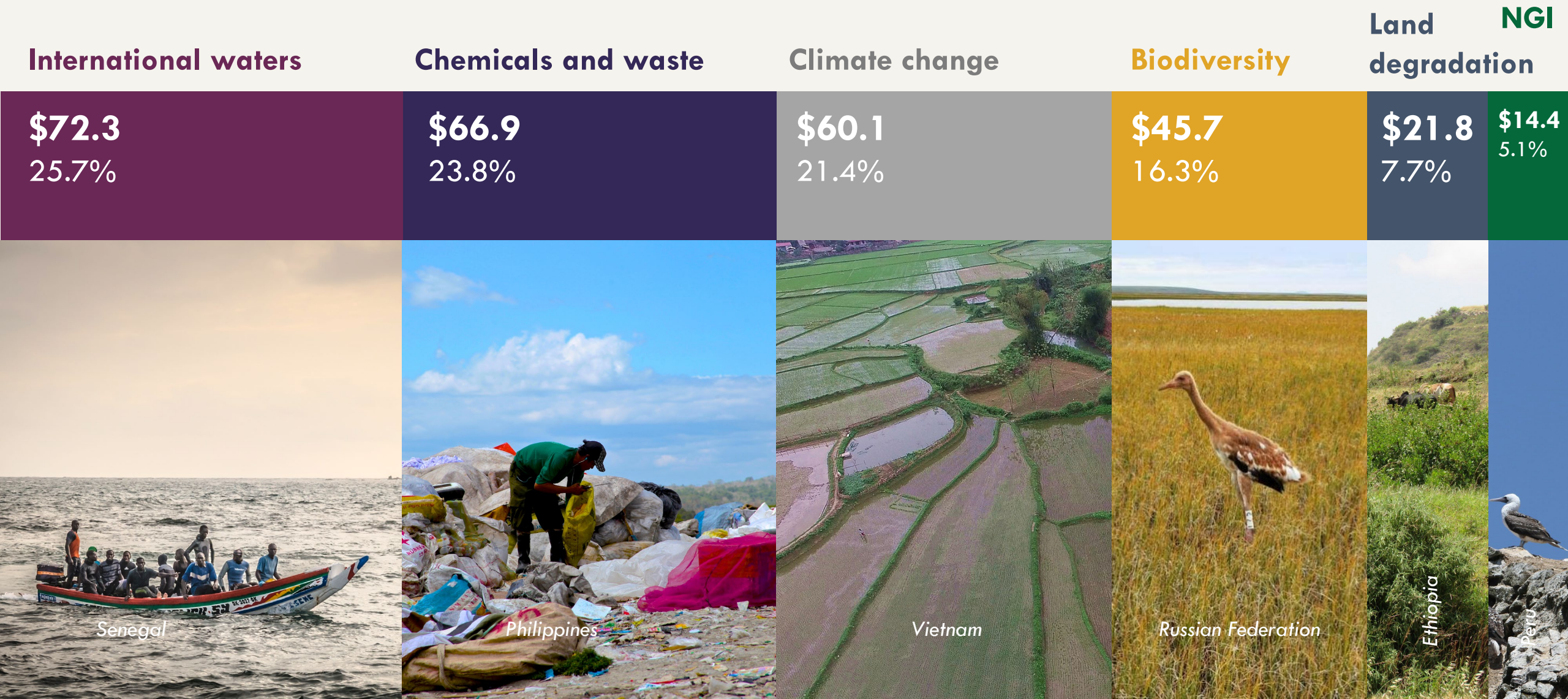
Investment mobilized ratio

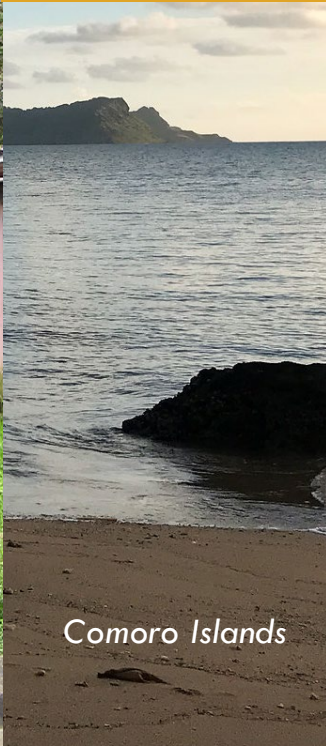

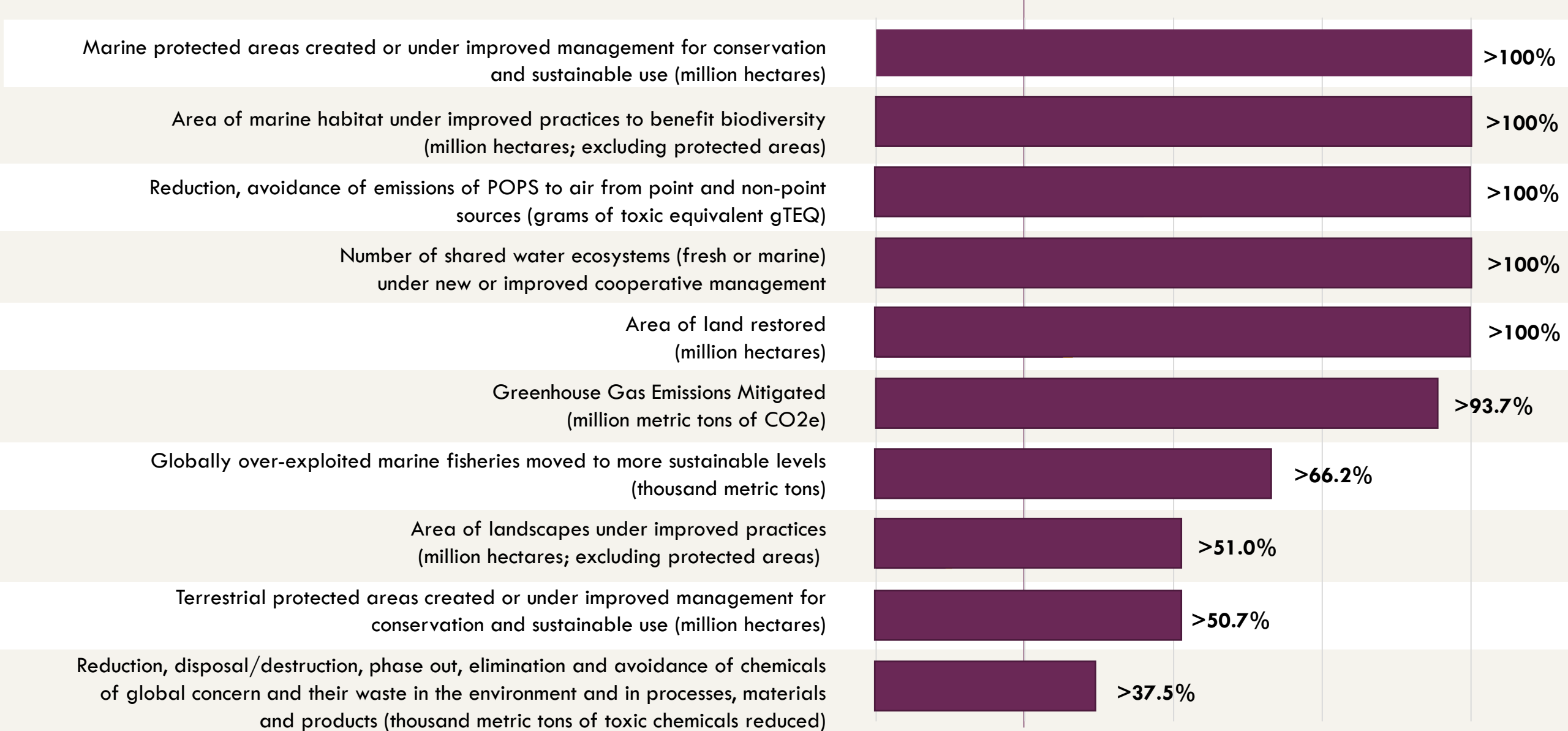

ADDRESSING THE PANDEMIC CHALLENGES
