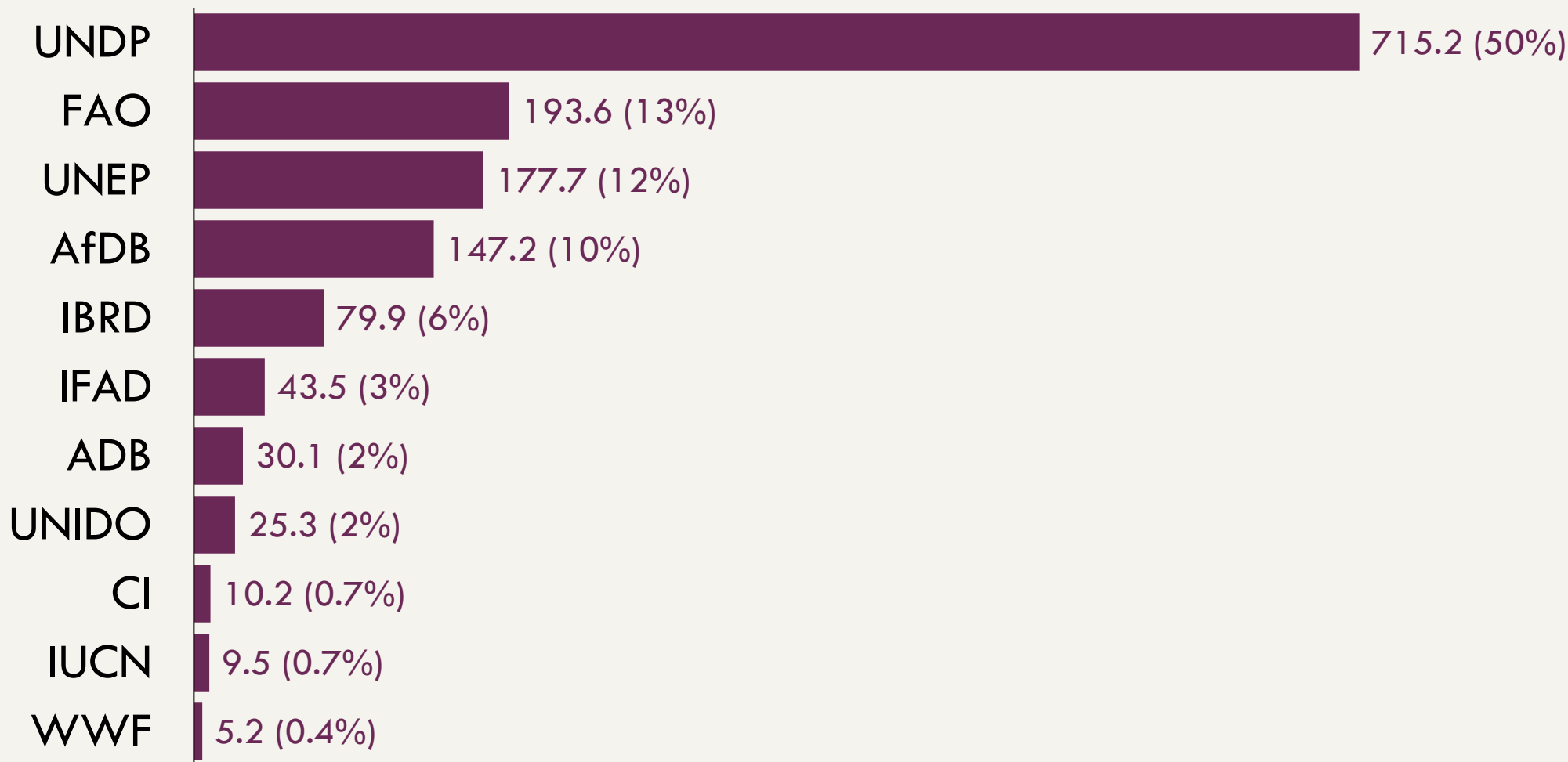

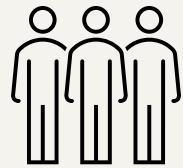

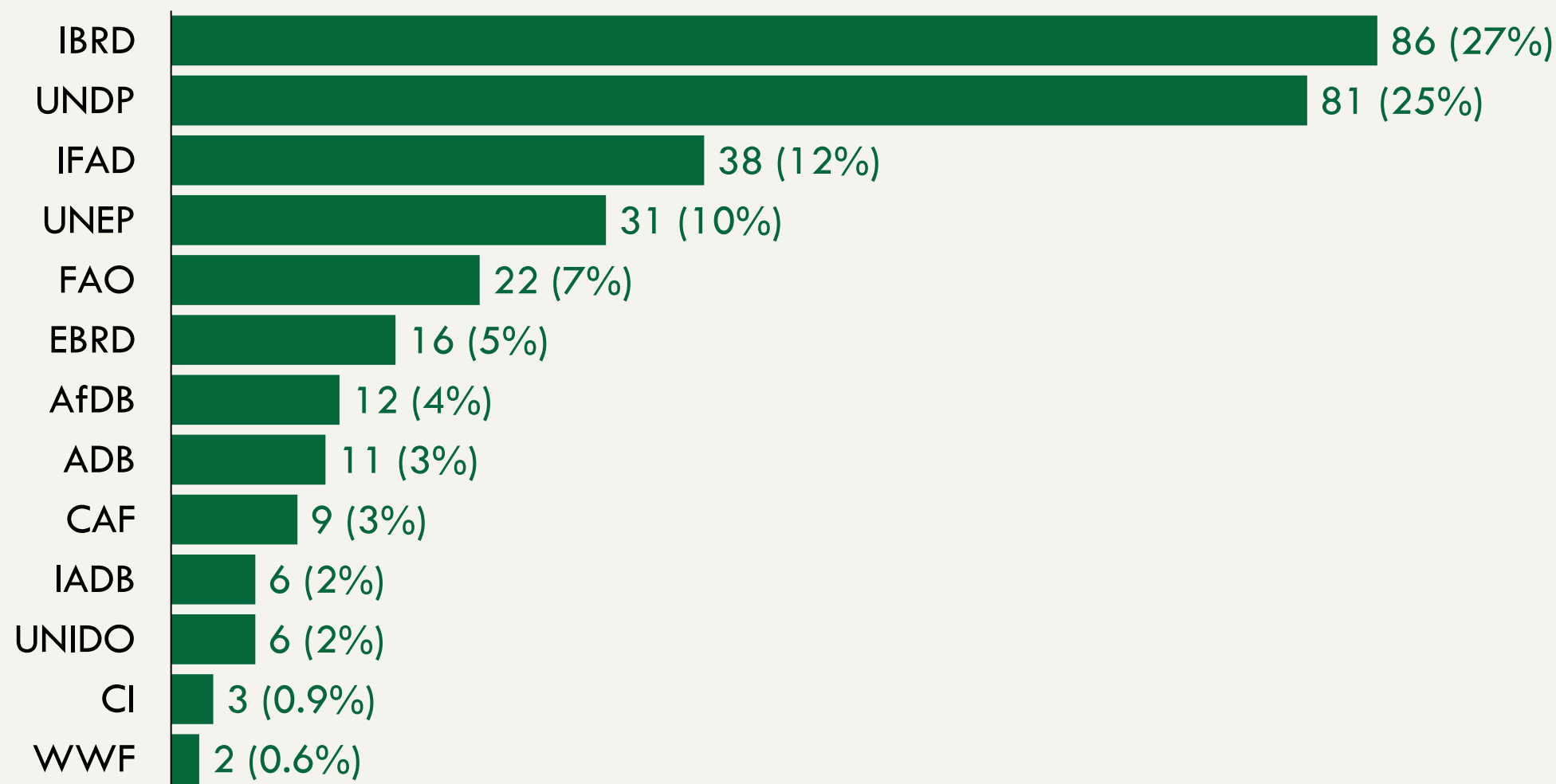

SCCF AGENCY DISTRIBUTION

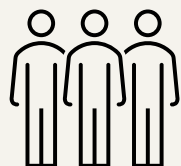

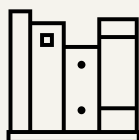
