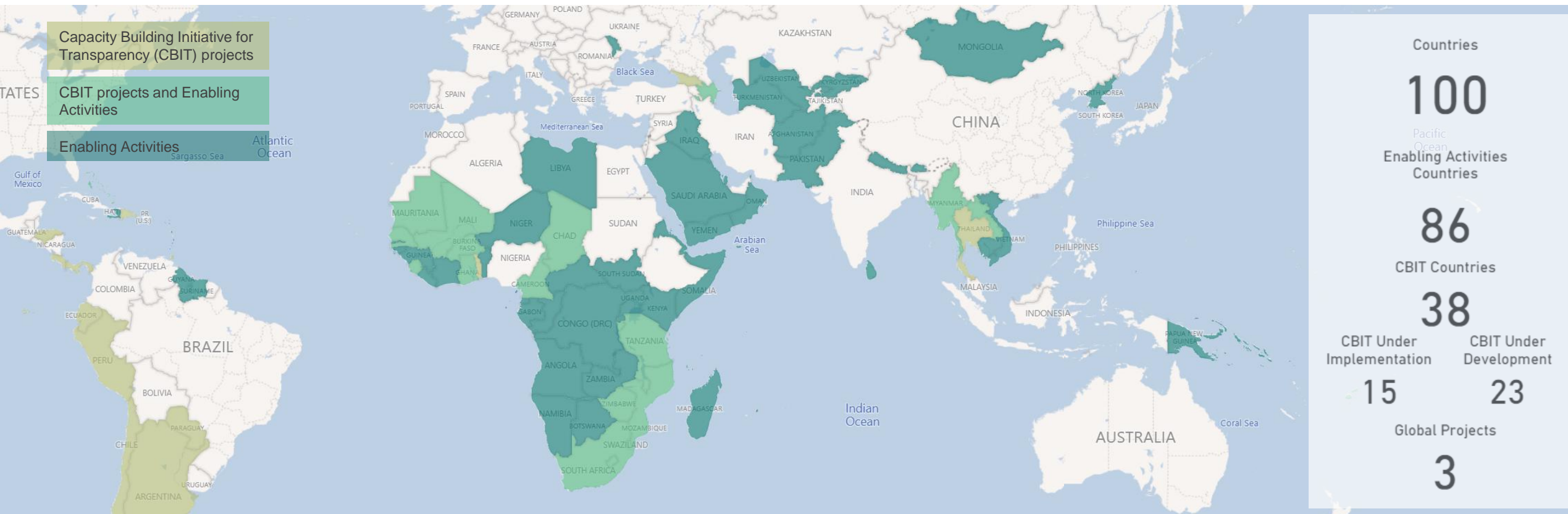

Role of UNEP in supporting the Enhanced Transparency Framework of the PA: -

- Supporting Parties to access GEF Funding for EAs (*National Communications & Biennial Update Reports*) and CBITs.
- Supporting EAs & CBIT implementation & provision of technical support through 2 Global Projects: -
 - Global Support Programme (GSP): UNEP-UNDP project, that aims to improve Countries' EAs reporting systems
 - CBIT Global Coordination Platforms: UNEP-UNDP project for supporting ETF
- Future plans of a '*CBIT Global Support Programme (UNEP/UNDP)*' – a global 'one-stop' shop platform for provision of technical support services for EAs and CBITs; and transitioning to BTRs

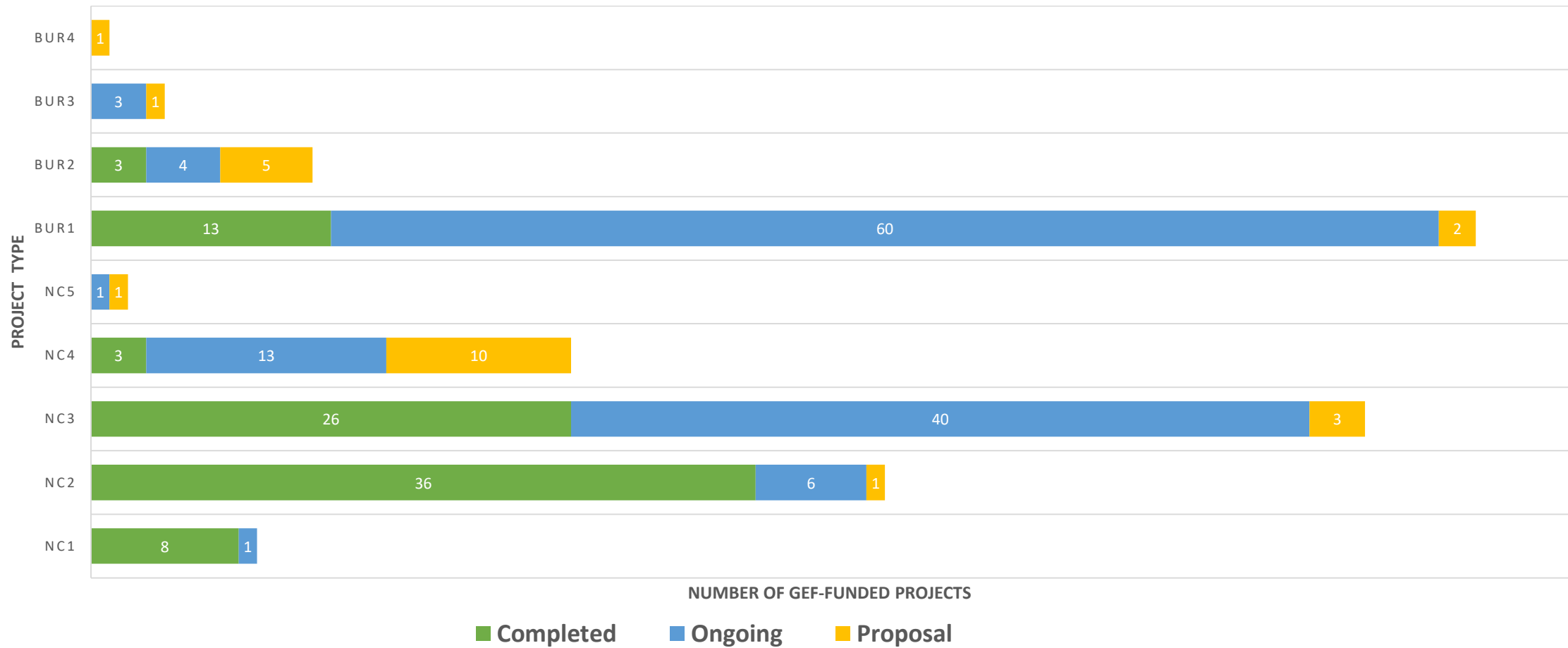

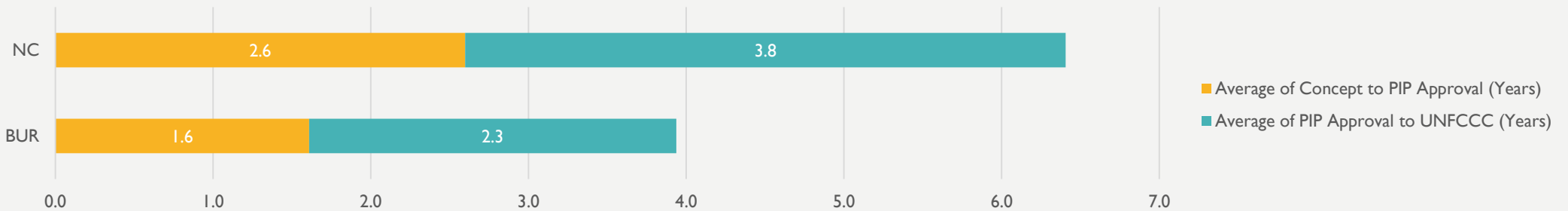
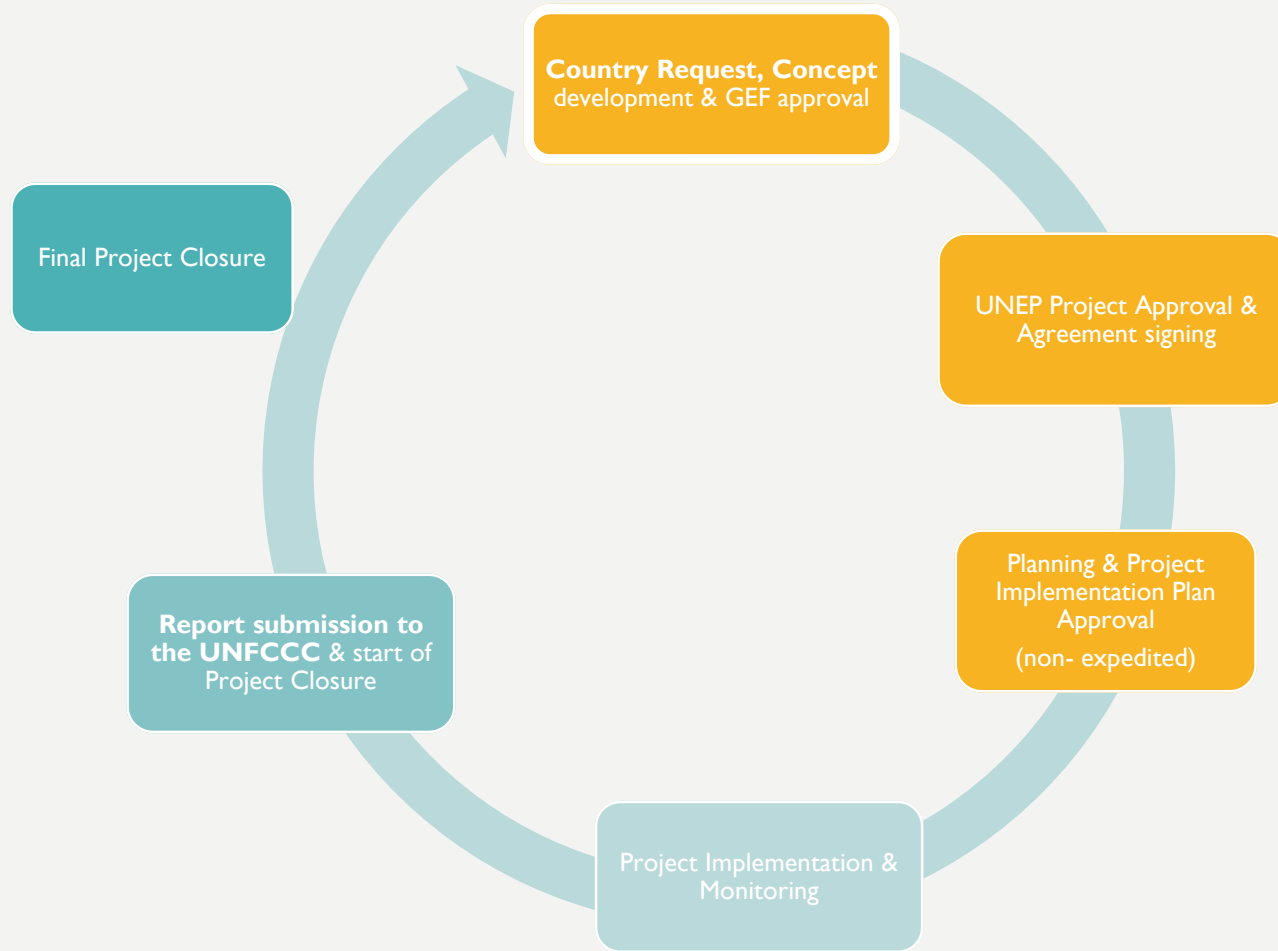
Costs Analysis: -

Our experience show that most countries utilize the total funds approved under EAs modality.

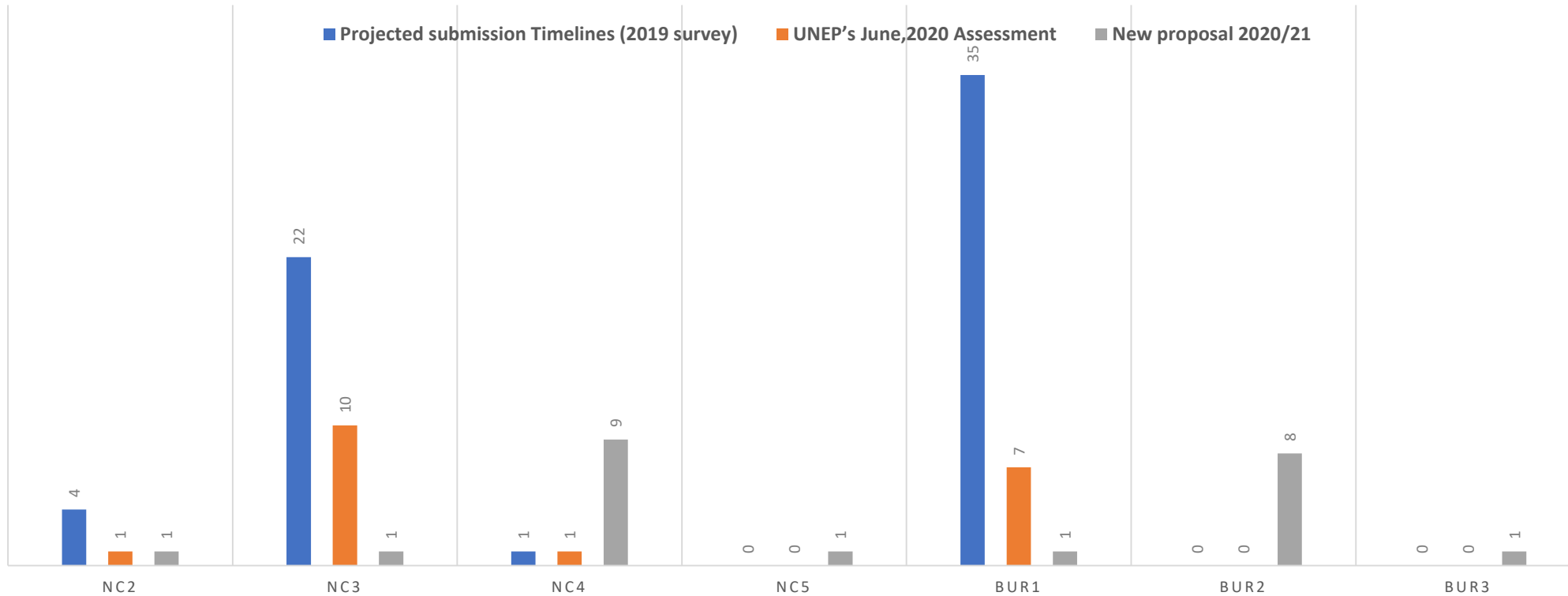
▪ 1 FSP – South Africa for 4M

- 5 Years Project timeline – 3 reports submitted to the UNFCCC. (2014 – 2019)
 - Out of US\$ 4,600,650 approved, appx. US\$ 2,298,487 disbursed to SA – balance to be returned
 - Reports completed; -
 - BUR2 : Dec, 2017
 - NC3: August 2018
 - BUR3: June, 2019
- South Africa developing a US\$ 852,000 proposal for NC4/BUR4

NC/BUR submissions Dates: -

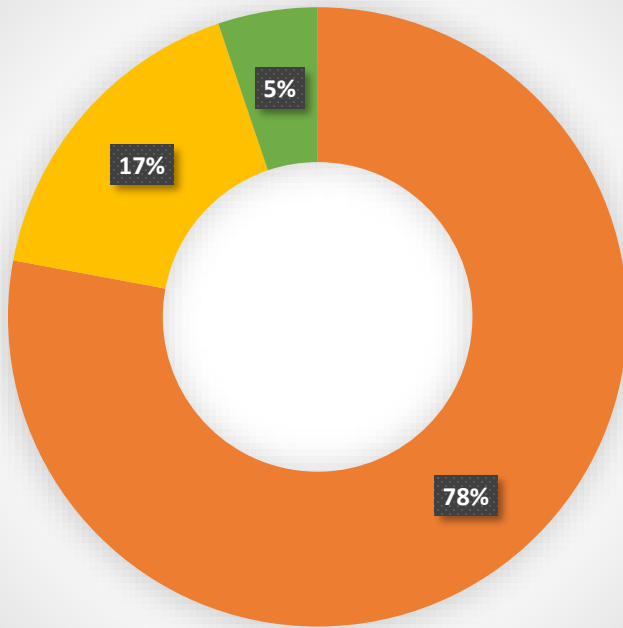
- impacts of COVID 19 on projected timelines & 'moving targets' from respondents

10 and 12 BUR & NCs proposal respectively, expected to be submitted to the GEF in Yr. 2020/21 –

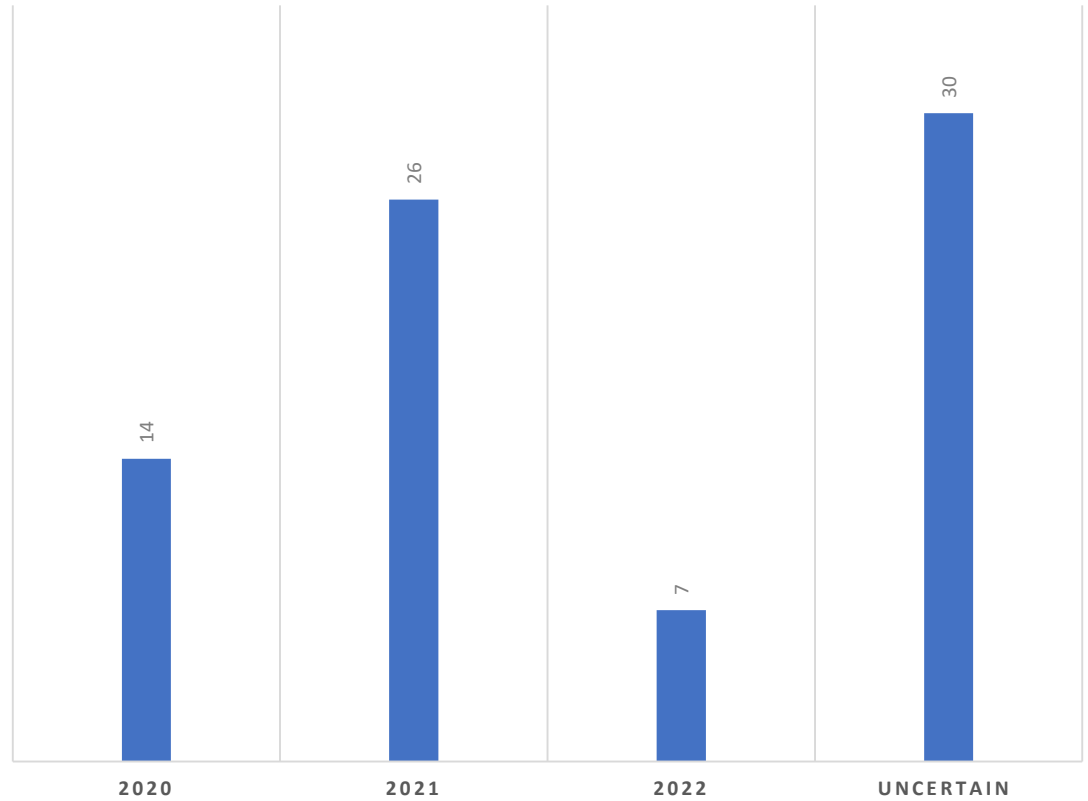
Yr. 2019 Responses on BTR readiness/awareness amongst NC/BUR Project staff

COUNTRY READINESS TO INITIATE BTRS – 77 RESPO

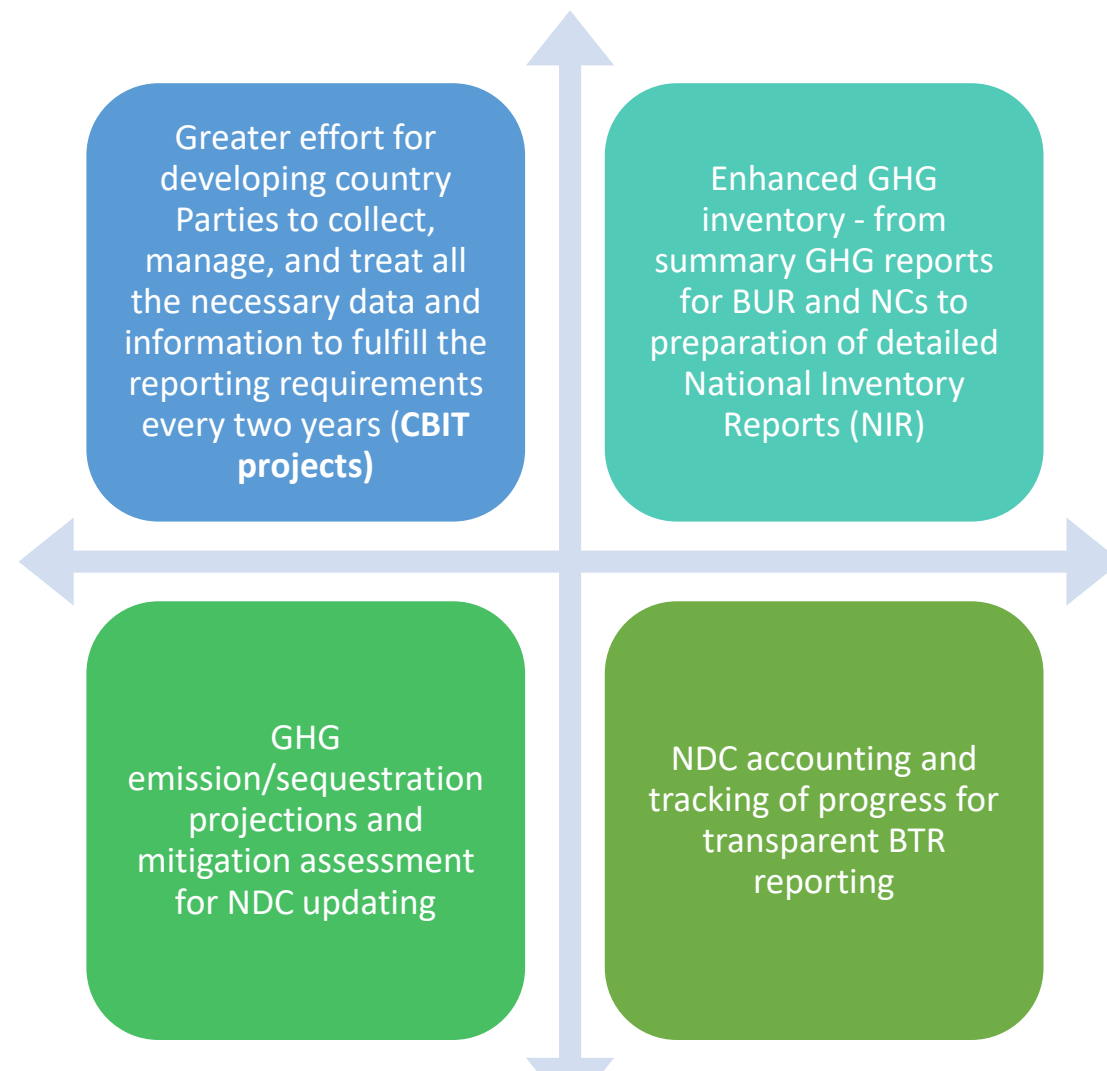


Issues to consider: -
