



A Vision to Transform Capacity Building



Coalition's Roles on Transparency





Coalition's Recommendations

- **1.** Initiate "Fast start" activities
- 2. Support country-lead facilitative peer assessment
- 3. Nurture and build embedded in-country professional communities
- 4. Broaden the scope of stakeholders for country MRV activities
- 5. Establish a common core of learning and professional development activities



Coalition's Recommendations

- 6. Use smart IT tools and innovative mentoring processes
- 7. Invest in pilot projects
- 8. Integrate capacity building with national priorities (e.g. energy security, health and poverty).
- 9. Develop new and embed climate knowledge in existing academic programmes (e.g. engineering, accountancy, biotechnology)
- **10.** Provide experts with a forum for discussion
