## CUMULATIVE GEF-5 APPROVALS VERSUS PROGRAMMING TARGETS AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2012

1. This bi-annual report summarizes the progress made in programming GEF-5 resources as of December 31, 2012. It provides a cumulative summary of GEF-5 utilizations against the programming targets that were established by the Council during the GEF-5 replenishment (GEF 5 Programming Document GEF/R.5/31/CRP.1). In addition, it details project approvals and endorsements as well as project cancellations during the six-month period from July 1 to December 31, 2012.

2. Total GEF grants and associated Agency fees approved by Council or the CEO amounted to \$2,104.96 million, representing 50 percent of programmed resources. The distribution of the approved amounts as compared to the corresponding programming targets is shown in Table 1 by focal areas, themes, programs and corporate budget.

## **APPROVAL OF GRANTS AND AGENCY FEES FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1 TO DECEMBER 31, 2012**

3. During the six-month period ended December 31, 2012, the GEF approved a total of \$207.09 million for financing projects, consisting of \$188.75 million in project grants, and \$18.34 million in associated fees to Agencies. Co-financing associated with total approval during this period was \$990.47 million (each GEF grant dollar was thus matched by approximately \$5.25 dollars in co-financing). Table 2 provides a summary illustration of the distribution according to project types.

## **CEO ENDORSEMENT OF PROJECTS FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1 TO DECEMBER 31, 2012**

5. Between July 1 and December 31, 2012, the CEO endorsed a total of 35 projects accounting for \$126.44 million in GEF grants and \$11.99 million in associated Agency fees, as detailed in Annex F.

## **PROJECT CANCELLATIONS FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1 TO DECEMBER 31, 2012**

6. During the six-month ended December 31, 2012, the GEF cancelled 7 projects (including one related PPG) of total value of \$5.91 million in GEF grants and \$0.56 million in associated Agency fees as detailed in Annex G.
