The GEF Academy is a GEF learning initiative that provides an online and face to face curriculum of courses/learning events designed to enhance the capacity of GEF partners and stakeholders to engage with the GEF and to deliver global environmental benefits through GEF funded initiatives.

The GEF Academy is accessible 24/7 and offers the GEF community a catalog of self-paced online courses and facilitated webinars, as well as face-to-face training events that draw on the latest knowledge and information regarding GEF policies, procedures and guidelines. Courses also provide global expertise, technical information, lessons learned, and best practices relevant to GEF investments.

Courses offered through the GEF Academy are developed and offered in partnership with GEF Agencies, GEF EGO and STAP, as well as other like-mided institutions that work on the global environment. The initial focus of the GEF Academy is to provide training on new policies and procedures that accompany the GEFs 7th replenishment.

Currently, three courses are available

This ecourse covers the GEF Results Framework which is used by the GEF Partnership to identify, capture, and earn from the results of its investments. Part 1 of this ecourse will take approximately 35 minutes to complete By completing this ecourse, you will gain an understanding of the GEF Results Framework and you will become familiar with the GEF oce indicators and how they can be used in the design, implementation, reporting, and evaluation of GEF projects and programs.

The course has two parts; Part 1 is a prerequisite for taking the more detailed Part 2. You will be able to continue to Part 2 of the course once Part 1 has been completed.



Steps to sign up as a new external user in the OLC member center and then log into Saba Cloud with the newly created profile.

1. Click the "E-course on the GEF Results Framework" link on the GEF website.

2. You will be redirected to the screen below with the option to Create Account in the sign-in form.

3. In the sign-in form that displays, provide an email, password, first name, last name, and other profile-related information.



4. After providing an email address, click the Send Verification Code button to receive a code from the World Bank Group.



5. Provide the verification code as indicated in the screenshot below.



6. Once the code is validated, fill in the remaining fields, such as password, first name, last name, etc., and click on the Create button.





7. Upon successful creation of the profile, the user will be redirected to the Login screen to enter an email address and click on the Next button.

Steps to login as an external user in OLC (Saba Cloud) with an existing/already created profile.

1. Click the "E-course on the GEF Results Framework" link in the GEF website.

2. You will be redirected to the login screen; enter the email address you wish to use for sign-up. Click on the Next button.



3. Enter the password associated with the email address and click on the Submit button.

#	Scenario	Resolution/Next Steps
1.	Unable to login as account is inactive/disabled in OLC	Contact old:old:old:old:old:old:old:old:old:old:
2.	Intermittently users are getting redirected to worldbank.org upon sign up	After completing the sign up, access the Saba course deep link URL <u>https://wbg.sabacloud.com/Saba/Web_spf/NA1PRD0002/common/leclassview/dowbt-00052588</u> in the same browser tab. You will be redirected to the OLC page without any password challenges.
3.	Invalid username/password	Change the password using the forgot password option.
4.	Unable to sign up/register in the sign up form	Ensure that all the mandatory fields are filled in prior to form submission. If issue persists, contact <u>olcsupport@worldbank.org</u> for assistance.
5.	Upon successful login, during redirection user receive BIG-IP error screen	This is due to conflicting user sessions. Pls switch to different browser and try logging in.
