OBJECTIVES AND COMPONENTS

Objectives

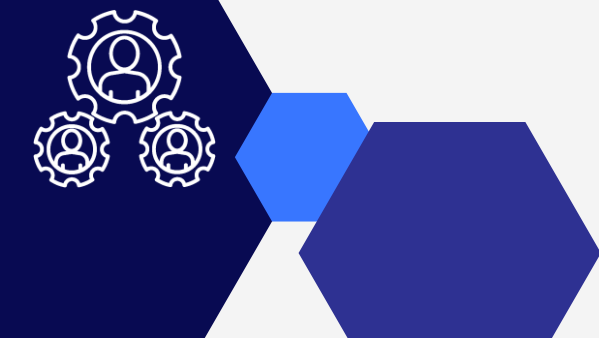
Help Côte d'Ivoire strengthen its transparency framework by putting in place the necessary foundations to monitor progress in the implementation of NDCs in accordance with the requirements of the Paris Climate Agreement.

Components

- Institutional arrangements for climate transparency;
- Provision of tools, training and assistance to meet the transparency provisions set out in the Paris Agreement;
- Tracking NDC Implementation Progress and Transparency

Budget GEF : 1,160,000 USD

Duration : 2019 - 2022



RESULT 1 : Institutional Arrangements

- A draft of the first climate change law for Cote d'Ivoire, submitted to the General Secretariat of the Government for the adoption process. A working session with parliamentarians has been done to discuss the content of this law and integrate their comments;
- An audio music and video production on climate change is available to support the public awareness on climate change;
- Memoranda of Understanding with key ministries for GHG inventory and MRV activities, and create a direct collaboration corridor on data exchange;
- A feasibility study aimed at setting up the National Expert Group on Climate Change (GENEC), (a sort of "national GIEC") to support climate transparency activities. Now, a draft of decree is under review by the key stakeholders.



RESULT 2 : Provision of tools, training and support

- A report on recommendations for the continuous improvement of GHG emissions inventories is available and the key challenges, needs and gaps have been highlights;
- The first Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QA/QC) procedures manual is available for GHG inventories;
- 25 national actors from key sector ministries were trained on the IPCC 2006 guidelines and how to use the IPCC 2006 software to increase the capacity from those actors to do their own GHG inventories in their respective sectors;
- 40 national actors from sector ministries were trained in the use of the QA/QC procedures manual;
- 50 national actors from sector ministries have been trained in the design and implementation of the NDC MRV system;
- A feasibility study of setting up an MRV system on the revised NDCs is available, and the deployment of this MRV system is on going to operationalize the MRV system to properly track the progress of the NDCs implementation.



RESULT 3 : NDC Progress and Transparency Tracker

- A national Transparency Dialogue has been organized in September 2022, and the key challenges, needs and gaps of the country to enhance the transparency framework and switch from BUR to BTR in 2024 have been identified with recommendations to overcome them. More than 250 key stakeholders attended this national event;
- A long-term climate change strategy is under development to support the long-term vision of the country on climate change actions and reporting requirement.
