

Overview of GEF Support to BTR


Provision of timely BTR1 support is a priority for GEF

86 BTRs in 68 countries supported since 2020

Every technically cleared proposal supported As of June 1, 2023:

- \$60.4 million to support BTRs
- BTR1 (69), BTR2 (17)
- Stand-alone BTR1 (22), Combined BTR1/NC (24), Top-up (6), Combined BTR1/BTR2/NC (17)
- Brazil, India, Malaysia, Mexico and Nigeria used their STAR
- 3 Agencies: UNEP, UNDP, and FAO




Overview of the Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency (CBIT)

Growing, balanced portfolio

- 89 projects in 87 countries totaling \$147 million
- 11 projects (13%) have completed implementation, 53 projects (62%) are under implementation
- 32 projects in Africa, 23 in LAC, 20 in Asia and 9 in ECA
- 5 global projects to enhance knowledge exchange, sector capacity
- 7 Agencies: CI, FAO, FECO, IDB, UNEP, UNDP, and WWF-US





Time duration between submission and approval

The average time between submission and CEO approval for projects below \$2 million is 3 months approx. While the average time between submission and CEO endorsement for projects above \$2 million is 13.3 months.

Growing demand. Growing demand for BTRs towards 2024 deadline




Synergies. Explore interlinkages and align BTR and CBIT projects



BTR Support Modalities

Stand-alone BTR

Up to \$600,000 from set-aside funding

- Available since January 2021
- Country must not have ongoing BUR support
- Ongoing NC is acceptable



BTR Support Modalities

Combined BTR/NC

Up to \$633,000 from set-aside funding

- Available since January 2021
- Country must not have ongoing NC or BUR support



BTR Support Modalities

Additional Financing (top-up)

Up to \$250,000 from set-aside funding

- Available for countries that, as of January 1, 2023, have an ongoing BUR or NC
- This option is only intended to be used for the first BTR
