# Global Environment Facility Strategy for Knowledge Management and Learning

- 6. Document GEF/C.65/03, Global Environment Facility Strategy for Knowledge Management and Learning, presents for Council consideration the Knowledge Management and Learning (KM&L) Strategy for the GEF Partnership. The Strategy provides an overall vision and roadmap of actions on KM&L to support and amplify impact of GEF programming on the global environment. This strategy is a culmination of the collective effort by the GEF partnership to foster a systematic and coordinated approach to KM&L.
- 7. Draft Decision: The Council, having reviewed document GEF/C.65/03, Global Environment Facility Strategy for Knowledge Management and Learning, approves the strategic directions proposed for knowledge management and learning, and encourages the GEF Secretariat to engage with Agencies and STAP in facilitating implementation of the Strategy.

# **Enhancing Policy Coherence through GEF Operations**

#### Relations with the Conventions and Other International Institutions

- 10. Document GEF/C.65/05, Relations with the Conventions and Other International Institutions, provides an update on the activities of the Global Environment Facility (GEF) in support of the following multilateral environmental agreements (MEAs): the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD), the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (the Stockholm Convention), the Minamata Convention on Mercury, and the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer (the Montreal Protocol). Covering the period from November 1, 2022, to March 31, 2023, the document also provides information on relations between the GEF Secretariat and other international conventions, institutions, and fora.
- 11. Draft decision: The Council, having considered document GEF/C.65/05, Relations with the Conventions and Other International Institutions, welcomes the report and requests the GEF network to continue to work with recipient countries to reflect the guidance and national priorities in their GEF programming and activities.
