## **PROGRESS REPORT ON THE LEAST DEVELOPED COUNTRIES FUND AND THE SPECIAL CLIMATE CHANGE FUND**

**Recommended Council Decision**

The LDCF/SCCF Council, having considered document GEF/LDCF.SCCF.39/03 *Progress Report on the Least Developed Countries Fund and the Special Climate Change Fund*, welcomes the report and takes note with appreciation the progress made under the LDCF and the SCCF.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. This report provides an update on the progress made in the operations of the Least Developed Countries Fund (LDCF) and the Special Climate Change Fund (SCCF) during the reporting period of April 1 to September 30, 2025.
2. As of September 30, 2025, total cumulative pledges to the LDCF amounted to \$2,314.21 million from 28 donors.<sup>1</sup> The total cash receipts was \$2,174.87 million, which is 94.0 percent of total potential resources.<sup>2</sup> Cumulative LDCF funding decisions by the LDCF/SCCF Council and the CEO amounted to \$2,342.67 million.<sup>3</sup> Resources available for new funding decisions amounted to \$47.78 million.<sup>4</sup>
3. New pledges totaling \$6.09 million were made to the LDCF during the period of April 1 to September 30, 2025, by Belgium and Ireland. The value of new contributions received during this period was \$6.19 million.
4. Since its inception, the LDCF has approved 442 projects. During this reporting period, in June 2025 the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council approved a Work Program consisting of four Full-Sized Projects (FSPs) with a total of \$39.55 million. In addition, two Medium-Sized Projects (MSPs) with a total of \$3.04 million were approved during this reporting period. Twenty-six LDCF projects were also CEO endorsed/approved for implementation during this reporting period.
5. Four LDCF projects, requesting a total of \$49.33 million, are presented to the 39<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in December 2025 for approval.<sup>5</sup> This is the seventh Work Program of the GEF-8 Period.
6. As of September 30, 2025, 51 least developed countries (LDCs) accessed approximately \$12.20 million in support of the preparation of National Adaptation Programs of Action (NAPAs). Additionally, LDCF support for formulation of National Adaptation Plan (NAP) processes totaled \$60.33 million as of September 30, 2025.
7. Since GEF-7, the LDCF has focused on NAP implementation, as countries are eligible to receive support from the Green Climate Fund (GCF) for NAP formulation.
8. The LDCF portfolio since inception aims to reduce the vulnerability of an estimated 88.90 million people and better manage 15.22 million hectares of land to withstand the effects of climate change. Further, 5.89 million people will be trained to identify, prioritize, implement, monitor and/or evaluate adaptation strategies and measures. Additionally, LDCF projects are

expected to develop or strengthen 5,010 policies, plans and frameworks to identify, prioritize, and integrate adaptation strategies and measures.

9. As for the SCCF, cumulative pledges by 16 donors amounted to \$492.95 million.<sup>6</sup> The total cash receipts were \$444.64 million, which is 90.2 percent of total potential resources. During this reporting period, Ireland made a new pledge of \$2.28 million. The value of new contributions received during this reporting period was \$2.34 million. Cumulative SCCF funding decisions by the Council and the CEO amounted to \$402.90 million.<sup>7</sup> Funds available to support Council or CEO decisions were \$72.38 million as of September 30, 2025.

10. Since its inception, the SCCF has approved support for 105 projects, including 26 Multi Trust Fund Projects (MTFs).<sup>8</sup> During the reporting period, one MSP with a total of \$1.12 million was approved. Three FSPs were CEO endorsed for implementation during this reporting period.<sup>9</sup>

11. One SCCF project requesting a total of \$2.93 million is presented to the 39<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in December 2025 for approval.<sup>10</sup>

12. SCCF window B focused on technology transfer, innovation, and private sector engagement, remains under-resourced despite recent contributions and its demonstrated strong potential for impact and engagement of non-traditional partners in the GEF including private sector actors.

13. The SCCF portfolio, since its inception, aims to reduce the vulnerability of an estimated 12.53 million people and better manage 5.30 million hectares of land to withstand the effects of climate change. Further, 271,888 people will be trained to identify, prioritize, implement, monitor and/or evaluate adaptation strategies and measures. Additionally, SCCF projects are expected to develop or strengthen 781 policies, plans and frameworks to identify, prioritize, and integrate adaptation strategies and measures.

14. The Challenge Program for Adaptation Innovation continues to deliver progress on effectively addressing unmet needs for climate change adaptation innovation. This program has created successful partnerships with climate adaptation innovation leaders, particularly in the private sector. During this reporting period, a comprehensive analysis of the projects supported, and insights gained to date through the first three rounds of this Challenge Program was presented in an Information Document prepared for the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council.<sup>11</sup>

## INTRODUCTION

1. This report provides an update on progress made in the operations of the Least Developed Countries Fund (LDCF) and the Special Climate Change Fund (SCCF) since the inception of the two funds, as well as specific activities during the reporting period of April 1 to September 30, 2025. Table 1 below presents a summary of LDCF and SCCF operations, including total cumulative pledges, paid contributions, and project approvals.

3. During this reporting period, the GEF Secretariat continued to actively engage on the Dedicated Programs that are defined in the GEF-8 Programming Strategy on Adaptation to Climate Change.<sup>13</sup> Progress being made through the Dedicated Programs is detailed in paragraphs 51 to 60.

## LEAST DEVELOPED COUNTRIES FUND

### Pledges and Contributions to the LDCF

4. As of September 30, 2025, total cumulative donor pledges and signed contribution agreements to the LDCF amounted to \$2,314.21 million from 28 donors.<sup>14</sup> The total cash receipts were \$2,714.87 million, which was 94.0 percent of total potential resources.<sup>15</sup>

5. New pledges totaling \$6.09 million were made to the LDCF in the period of April 1 to September 30, 2025, from Belgium and Ireland. The value of new contributions during this period was \$6.19 million. Figure 1 shows total annual and cumulative LDCF contributions finalized for each fiscal year.<sup>16</sup> Funds available to support new Council or CEO approvals amount to \$47.78 million, as per the most recent data provided by the Trustee.<sup>17</sup>

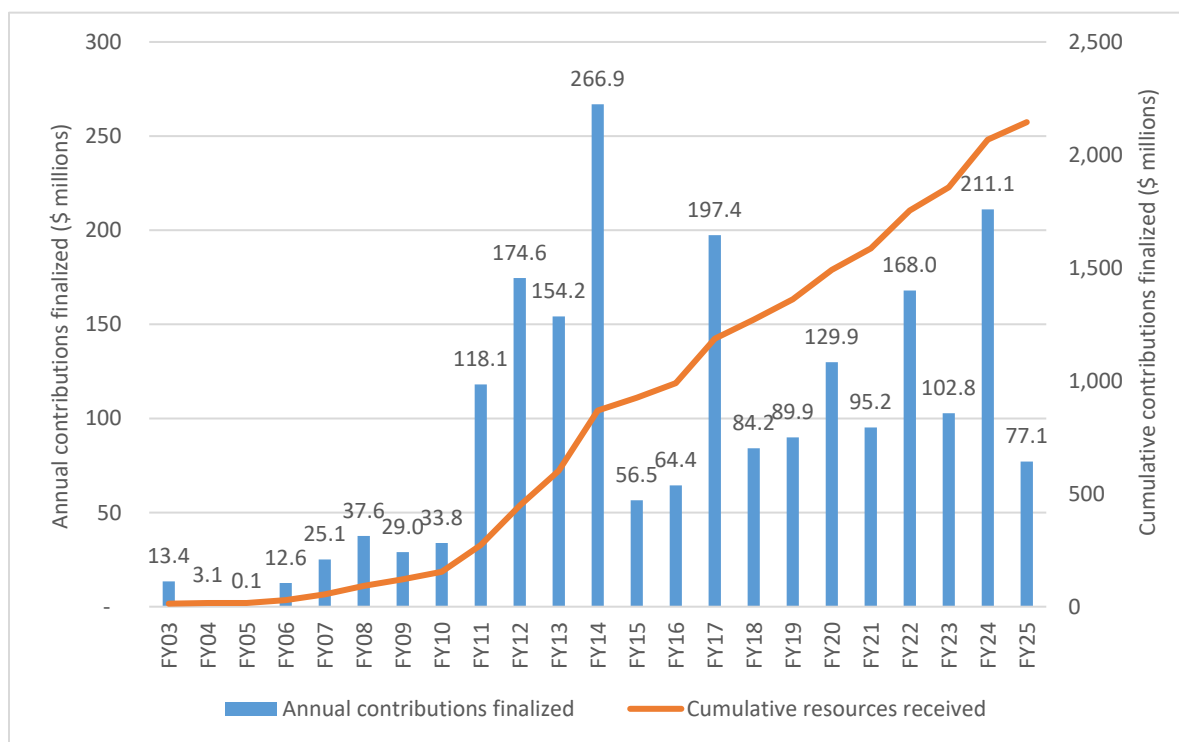

### Progress in LDCF Operations

6. During the reporting period, four projects were approved by the LDCF/SCCF Council as part of the Work Program presented to the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in June 2025, for a total of \$39.55 million in GEF project financing and Agency fees. This includes three national projects from two African LDCs (Madagascar and Uganda), one Asian LDC (Solomon Islands), and one multi-country program that targets Chad and Mali. In addition, one national project from Zambia and one global project were approved as MSPs for a total of \$3.04 million. Combining FSPs and MSP, total LDCF programming for this reporting period is \$42.59 million.

7. As of September 30, 2025, the LDCF has provided \$12.20 million in direct support for the preparation of NAPAs.<sup>19</sup> The LDCF and SCCF completed its support for NAPA preparation in GEF-6, while it continues to support their implementation as appropriate. South Sudan was the most recent country to submit its NAPA to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in 2017, bringing the total number of countries that have completed and

submitted their NAPAs to 51.<sup>20</sup>

8. In addition to financing the urgent and immediate adaptation needs of LDCs and the LDC work programme, the LDCF is also mandated to support NAP processes, which is an iterative and ongoing process enabling medium and long-term planning for adaptation.<sup>21</sup> As of September 30, 2025, total funding from the LDCF toward LDCs' NAP formulation processes amounts to \$60.33 million.<sup>22</sup> This includes projects in Chad, Democratic Republic of Congo, Djibouti, Guinea-Bissau, Lao PDR, Niger, Rwanda, and Senegal. It also includes three global projects with LDCF resources amounting to \$13.69 million approved to support the preparation of the NAP process in LDCs, and the implementation of elements of the LDC work programme other than NAPAs. The three global projects to support the preparation of the NAP process have all been fully implemented and financially closed. The figures are consistent with information provided in the Progress Report presented to the 32nd LDCF/SCCF Council in June 2022.<sup>23</sup>

9. The GCF and GEF have continued to work together to offer streamlined and coordinated support to countries and to avoid overlap, including as related to the NAP process. GCF and GEF coordination on climate change adaptation projects enable countries to move more effectively towards the integration of climate change adaptation considerations across key policies, plans, programs, and decision-making processes, in line with guidance from the Conference of the Parties (COP) to the UNFCCC,<sup>24</sup> as well as a LDCF/SCCF Council decision to operationalize support towards NAP process.<sup>25</sup>

10. As of September 30, 2025, the cumulative LDCF funding decisions amount to a total of \$2,342.67 million.<sup>26</sup> Projects support the implementation of priorities defined in NAPAs, NAPs and NDCs. Figure 2 illustrates annual and cumulative LDCF funding approvals by fiscal year. Notably, the amount of GEF funds programmed in FY 2024 (\$402.2 million inclusive of agency fees and PPG) is the highest in a single FY in the history of the LDCF. It is also important to note that LDCF approvals in FY 2025 have been limited by the availability of funds with which to do so, despite having more projects technically ready for approval.

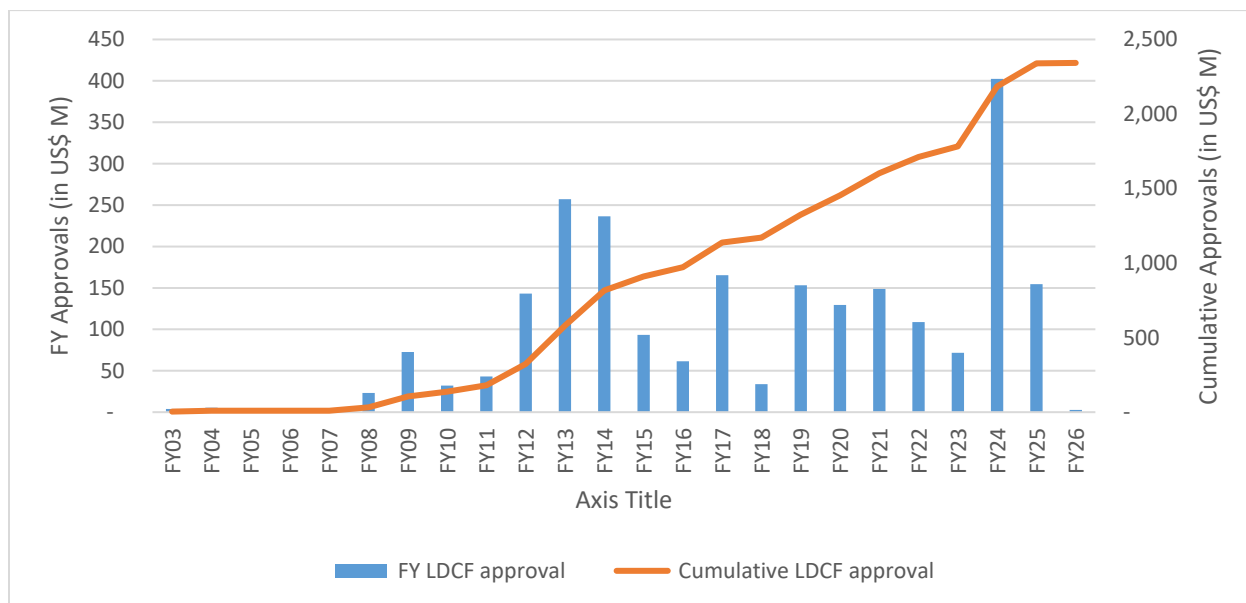

**LDCF Resource Access for GEF-8 Period**

11. For the GEF-8 period starting on July 1, 2022, the LDCF initial resource access cap for which each LDC can draw doubled to \$20 million. Table 3 shows the GEF-8 and cumulative status of LDCF resources accessed by each LDC, as of September 30, 2025.

### CEO Approvals and Endorsements

12. During the reporting period, twenty-six LDCF projects (including three MTF projects) totaling \$249.29 million in GEF project financing were CEO endorsed, or CEO approved<sup>29</sup> (see Table 4). These projects are expected to directly benefit over 8.78 million people (49.3 percent women).

13. In total, 393 projects<sup>30</sup> have been CEO endorsed or approved as of September 30, 2025,

including the twenty-six projects during this reporting period as reflected in Table 4.

14. The revised Project Cancellation Policy that took effect March 1, 2019, has been applied to improve the operational efficiency of the GEF.<sup>31</sup> Under this revised policy, if a FSP has not been submitted for CEO endorsement within 12 months of the date of Council approval or if it has not been CEO endorsed after 18 months, the project may be subject to cancellation. All projects approved in the June 2019 LDCF Work Program and thereafter fall under the revised Cancellation Policy. The actual time between the PIF approval and CEO endorsement of all two-step FSPs during this reporting period that are governed by the current cancellation policy ranged from 7 months to 20 months, with the average time between PIF approval and CEO endorsement being 17 months.<sup>32</sup> No project submitted notifications of delayed submission, nor requested for extension invoking force majeure during this reporting period.

15. Since the revised Cancellation Policy was implemented, 30 projects submitted notifications of delayed submission, while 36 projects submitted an extension request of the actual CEO endorsement deadline invoking force majeure to avoid project cancellation during the reporting period of the FY 2025 Annual Monitoring Review (AMR) of the LDCF and SCCF.<sup>33</sup> As shown in the FY 2025 AMR, no GEF-8 project has requested consideration for extension under the force majeure, as all Council-approved GEF-8 projects are within 12 months timeframe of the policy requirement for agencies to submit FSPs for CEO endorsement after Council Approval.<sup>34</sup>

16. The following are examples of projects that were CEO endorsed during this reporting period, with a brief description of their expected results and impacts.

17. *Sao Tome and Principe: Development of the transport and coastal protection sector* (GEF ID 11552); GEF Agency: World Bank; GEF Project Financing: \$12,844,037 (LDCF); Co-financing: \$42,100,000. The project mobilizes \$300 million in co-financing from the World Bank IDA resources to address the highly climate-vulnerable road transport sector in Sao Tome and Principe, an African LDC SIDS. This will be achieved by facilitating the integration of additional adaptation considerations in the context of the World Bank's Road Development project in Sao Tome and Principe, though a mix of green (nature-based) and grey (infrastructure) solutions. These include stabilization of slopes to limit storm surge impact; planting climate-resilient species; and improving drainage to cope with greater surface flows (this will also allow for the continuous use of public roads used to access schools). Studies analyzing gaps in community (including women's) engagement in climate-resilient road asset management will be undertaken, and training protocols developed on implementing nature-based approaches in the protection of climate vulnerable areas. The project will prioritize roads that are particularly degraded that provide access to schools and will incorporate measures to increase the safety of women and girls, to ensure sustainable and inclusive resilient development. The project will deliver adaptation benefits to 84,458 people (50.0 percent women), integrate climate resilience considerations in two policies or plans, and train 1,640 people (50.0 percent women) to identify and manage climate risks.

18. *Burkina Faso: Program to Strengthen Smallholder Resilience to Climate Change (RESI-2P)* (GEF ID 11365); GEF Agency: International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD); GEF project financing: \$ 8,932,420 (LDCF); Co-financing: \$92,155,200. The project aims to enhance the adaptive capacity of the agriculture sector in Burkina Faso through innovative agro-ecological adaptation solutions, improved governance, increased investments, and a whole-of-society approach, delivering food security and sustainable livelihoods. The interventions target two

impacts which include resilient production systems and strengthening of value addition and market access for products based on sustainable solutions. These two impacts will be delivered in a synergistic manner to create both a “pull” effect from the market asking for more sustainable products and a “push” effect with sustainable products readily available. The total LDCF financing requested by IFAD for Burkina Faso for this project is \$10.00 million which will leverage an IFAD loan of nearly \$92.00 million to run parallel to the LDCF investments for the period of 2024 to 2031. The project will deliver several benefits and co-benefits in terms of increased adaptive capacity, environmental restoration, and social inclusion. It will benefit 25,957 people (45.0 percent female and 50.0 percent young people) in poor rural households in Burkina Faso. The project investments cover 36 municipalities in two regions, the North and the Centre-West and will also support improved management of 16,570 hectares of agriculture land.

### **Agency Involvement in LDCF Projects**

19. Since the LDCF inception and up to September 30, 2025, 12 GEF Agencies have been involved in LDCF projects and programs. The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) has the largest cumulative share of project funding approvals since inception at 40.8 percent, the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) at 13.9 percent, United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) at 11.5 percent, and the World Bank at 9.5 percent, as shown in Figure 3. Other GEF Agencies implementing LDCF projects are African Development Bank, Asian Development Bank (ADB), Banque Ouest Africaine de Développement (West African Development Bank - BOAD), Conservation International (CI), IFAD, International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), and the World Wildlife Fund-US (WWF-US).<sup>36</sup> The share of UNDP programming has steadily decreased, with an increasing number of GEF Agencies engaged in climate adaptation support and growth of programming with multilateral development banks (MDBs) and international financing institutions (IFIs).

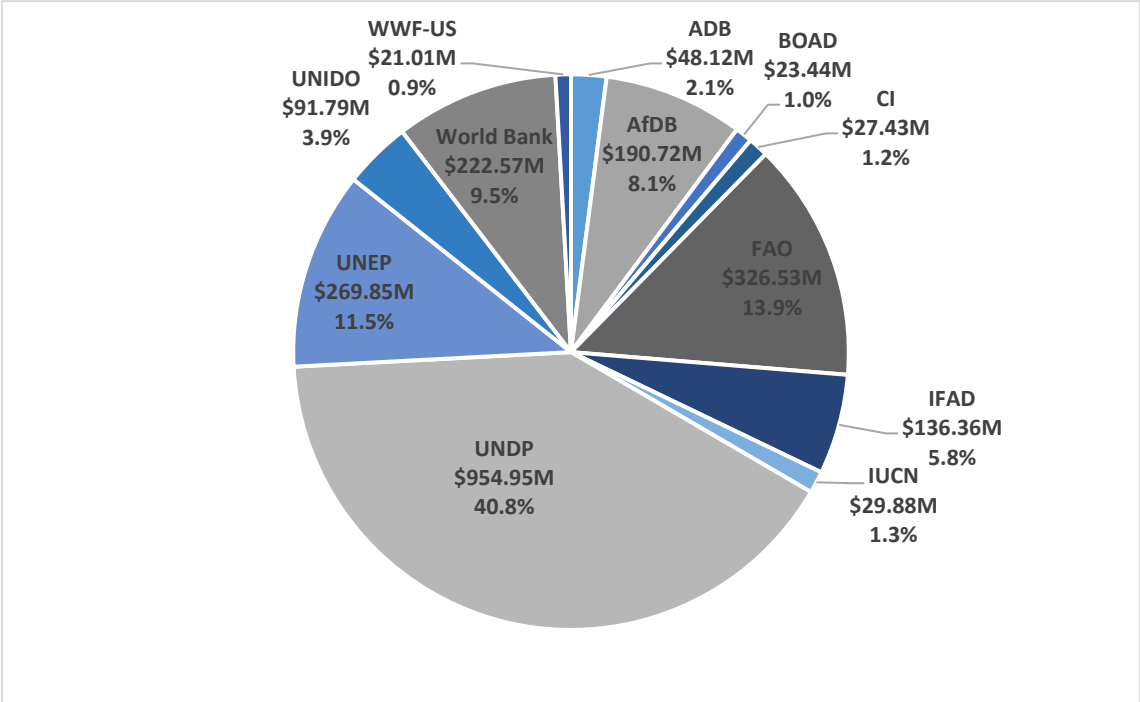
20. Following guidance of the Council and the GEF-8 policy recommendations, progress continues to be made for more balanced distribution of LDCF financing among Agencies including an aspirational ceiling for any one Agency of no more than 30.0 percent and an aspirational target for the regional multilateral banks and IFAD of 10.0 percent of the approved amounts. The share of MDBs and IFAD in LDCF funding approvals since inception increased to 25.5 percent on September 30, 2025, compared to 22.0 percent at the end of the GEF-7 period in June 2022.

21. Thus far in GEF-8, with six Work Programs, eleven Agencies have been involved in LDCF projects with a balanced Agency share. The share of the LDCF portfolio by MDBs and IFAD approved in the GEF-8 period is currently 31.8 percent. At the agency level, no Agency has a share above 25 percent, which is below the GEF-8 aspirational ceiling of 30 percent. UNDP has the largest share of the project funding approvals at 24.2 percent, followed by the World Bank at 19.0 percent, as shown in Figure 4.

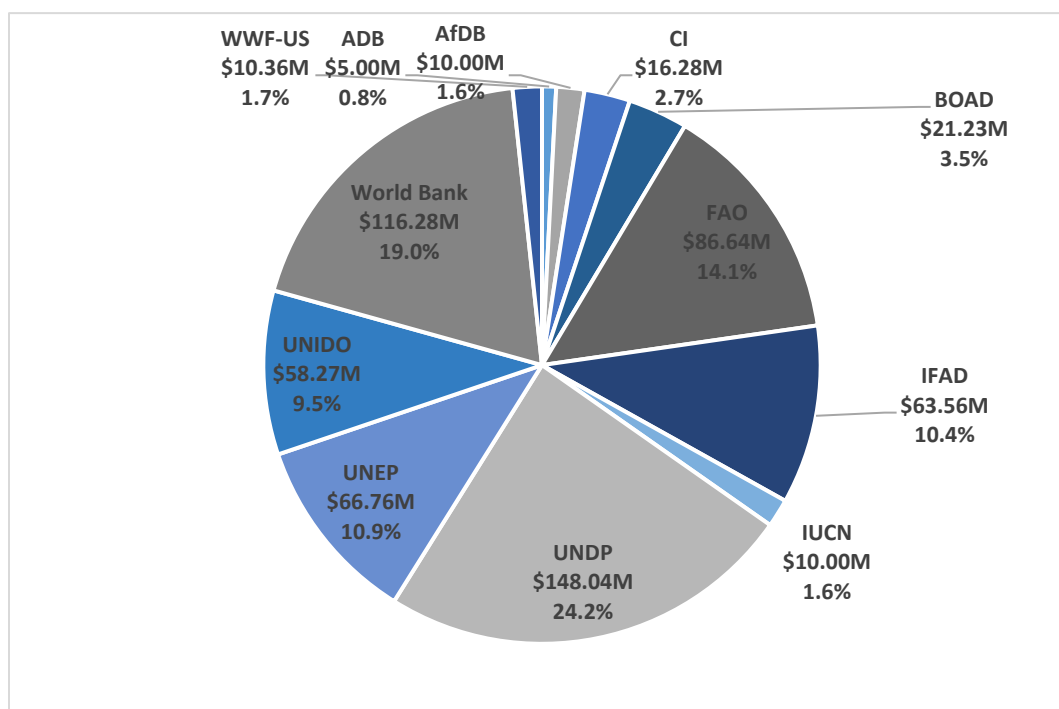

### Expected Results under the LDCF

22. Key expected results of the approved LDCF projects are summarized in Table 5. Full expected results can be found in the results frameworks specific to each project, available in the project documents posted on the GEF website.<sup>39</sup>

23. In response to the request made at the 14<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council meeting in June 2013, the GEF Secretariat, in its AMR of the LDCF and the SCCF, continues to provide a summary of actual, portfolio-level results of projects that have been completed or that are under implementation. The AMR reporting results for FY 2025 are presented at the 39<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in December 2025.<sup>40</sup>

24. The LDCF portfolio of approved projects seeks to directly reduce the vulnerability of more than 88.90 million people. LDCF projects are supporting countries in their efforts to integrate climate change adaptation into an expected 5,010 policies, plans, and processes to identify, prioritize, and integrate adaptation strategies and measures. The LDCF also assists countries in laying the groundwork for climate-resilient development by training an expected 5.89 million people to identify, prioritize, implement, monitor and/or evaluate adaptation strategies and measures.

25. Since the start of GEF-6 in July 2014, which is when LDCF/SCCF began systematically tracking sex disaggregated data, 31.70 million of the 65.89 million (48.1 percent) expected project beneficiaries of LDCF projects are female, and 2.53 million of the 5.17 million (49.0 percent) expected people trained are female.

26. The LDCF and SCCF results framework has been updated for GEF-8 projects, as presented in the GEF-8 Programming Strategy on Adaptation to Climate Change. Updates include a new core indicator related to private sector engagement, a new core sub-indicator on hectares of coastal or marine area managed for climate resilience and tracking of age disaggregation. The updated results framework is used for all newly approved LDCF and SCCF projects in GEF-8.

27. The 6 LDCF projects approved in the reporting period<sup>46</sup> are expected to directly benefit 61.37 million people (51.5 percent women), bring 0.20 million hectares of land under climate resilience, strengthen climate adaptation in 546 policies or frameworks, train 2.15 million people (47.1 percent women), and result in 352 private sector enterprises engaged in climate change adaptation and resilience action.

28. The GEF Policy on Gender Equality and GEF Policy on Stakeholder Engagement also apply to LDCF projects.<sup>47</sup>

### Sectoral Distribution

29. Each LDCF funded project focuses on one or more sectors/adaptation themes that align with national priorities outlined in countries' NAPAs, NAPs, and other relevant strategies. Figure

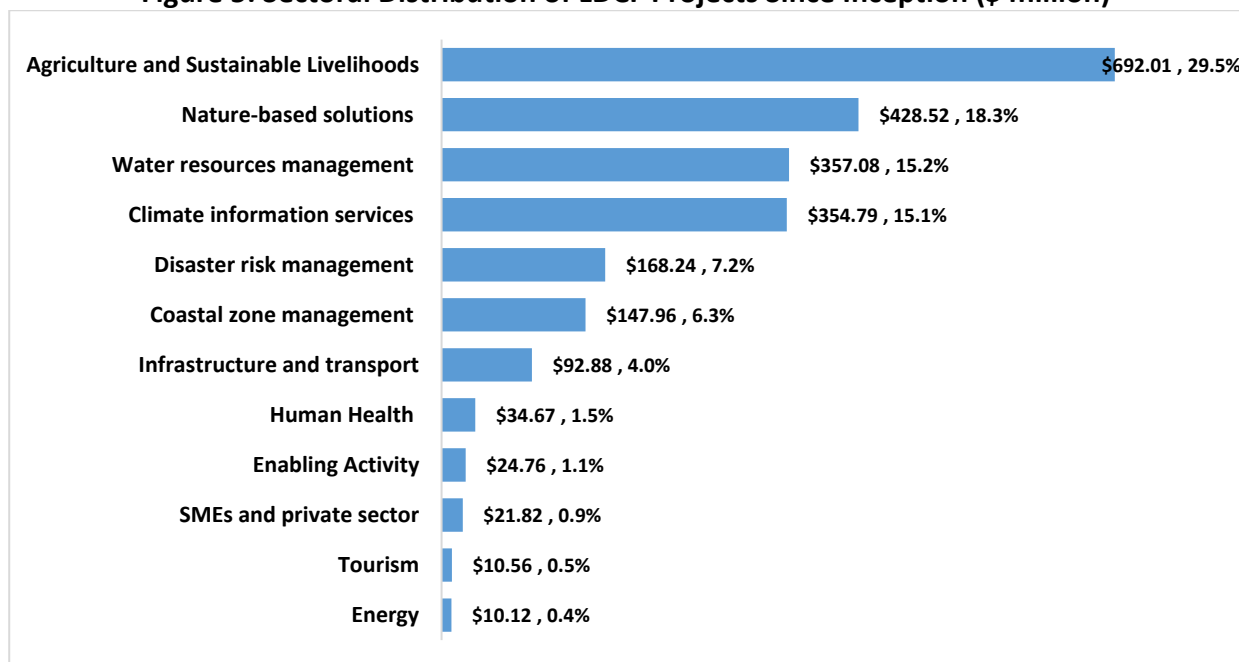

5 provides the cumulative sectoral and thematic distribution of all LDCF projects since inception.<sup>48</sup> Agriculture, nature-based solutions, water, and climate information services are the themes with the greatest focus among all LDCF projects.

## SPECIAL CLIMATE CHANGE FUND

### Pledges and Contributions to the SCCF

30. As of September 30, 2025, total cumulative donor pledges to the SCCF were \$492.95 million from 16 donors, including \$415.11 million towards the Program for Adaptation and \$77.85 million towards the Program for Technology Transfer.<sup>49</sup> As shown in Figure 6, the SCCF received more robust contributions in FYs 2023, 2024, and 2025 following several years of limited support. The total cash receipts were \$444.64 million, which is 90.2 percent of the total potential resources.<sup>50</sup> Figure 6 presents annual SCCF contributions and cumulative resources received by FY.

31. During the current reporting period of April 1 to September 30, 2025, Ireland made a new pledge of \$2.28 million. The value of new contributions received for SCCF during this reporting period was \$2.34 million. Funds available to support new Council or CEO approval were \$72.38 million, as per the most recent data provided by the Trustee for September 30, 2025.<sup>51</sup>

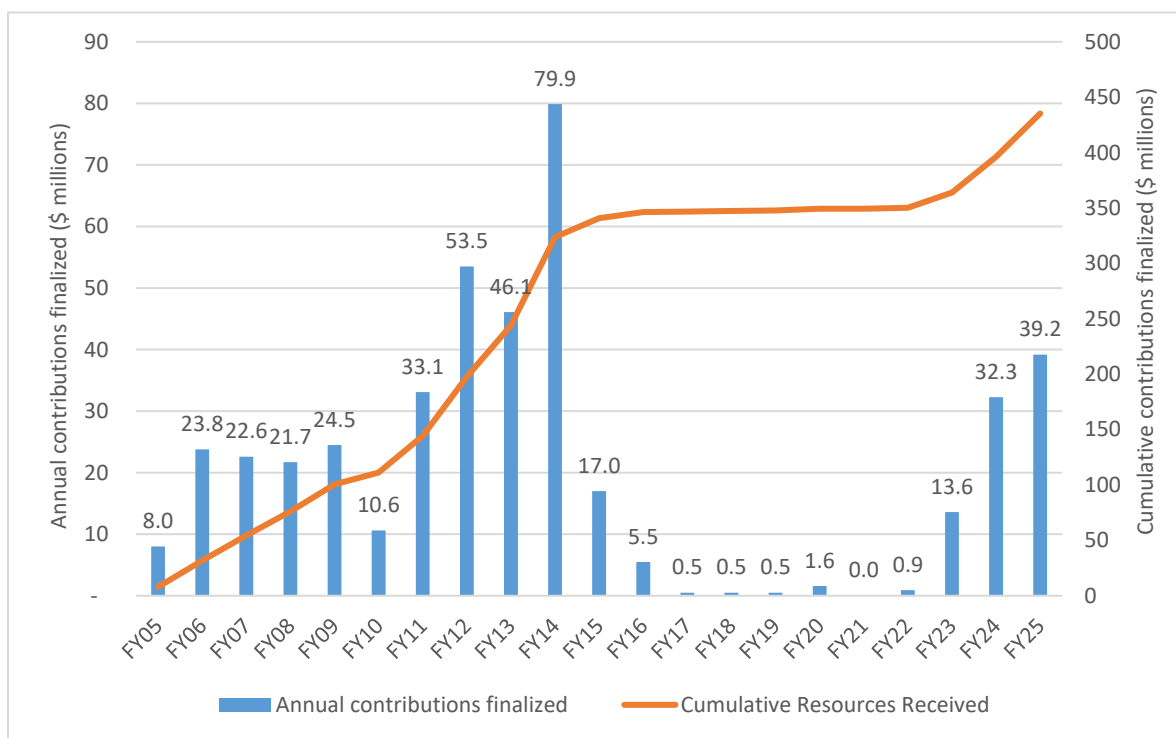

### Progress in SCCF Operations

32. During the current reporting period of April 1 to September 30, 2025, no project was approved by the LDCF/SCCF Council as part of the Work Program presented to the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in June 2025. With the increase in the ceiling for MSPs to \$5 million, stand-alone SCCF projects are likely to be approved by the GEF CEO as MSPs given the SCCF window A ceiling of \$3 million per SIDS. ne Global MSP<sup>53</sup> was approved for \$1.12 million, inclusive of GEF project finance, agency fee, and PPG.

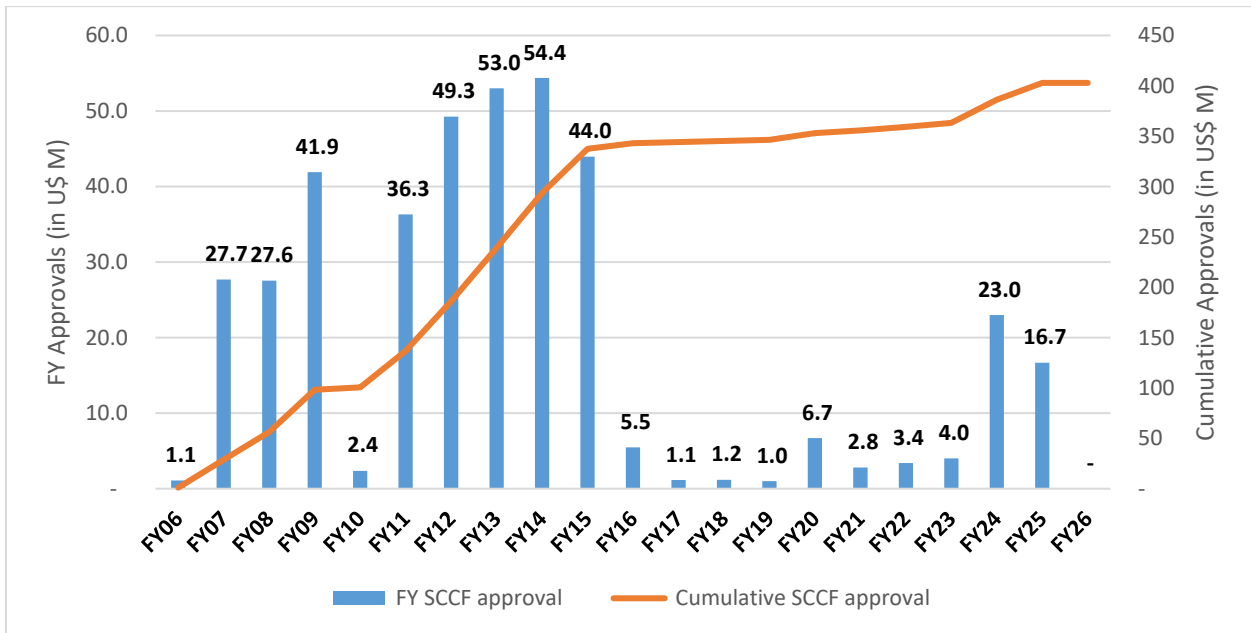
33. As of September 30, 2025, cumulative SCCF funding decisions amounted to a total of \$402.90 million.<sup>54</sup> There has been a total of 105 projects approved for SCCF support since inception, including MSPs. Annex II presents a complete list of approved projects to date under SCCF-A and B. Figure 7 shows SCCF approvals by fiscal year.

**CEO Endorsements**

34. During the reporting period, three FSPs and one MSP were CEO endorsed or approved. These projects total \$21.12 million including GEF project grant, agency fees, PPG, and PPG fees. One of these projects was fully supported by SCCF window A which focuses on the adaptation needs of SIDS, while two were supported jointly by both SCCF window A and the GEF Trust Fund (GET). The approved MSP during this reporting period was a global one-step MSP project that was supported jointly by the LDCF and SCCF window B, which focuses on focuses on technology transfer, innovation, and private sector engagement. These four projects are expected to directly benefit over 3.04 million people (49.9 percent women).

35. Details of the project that was approved during this reporting period are shown in Table 6.

36. In total, 100 SCCF projects had been CEO endorsed or approved as of September 30, 2025.

37. The following is the SCCF project that was CEO approved during this reporting period the one-step approach. This project was fully CEO approved approximately 4.5 months after it was initially submitted.

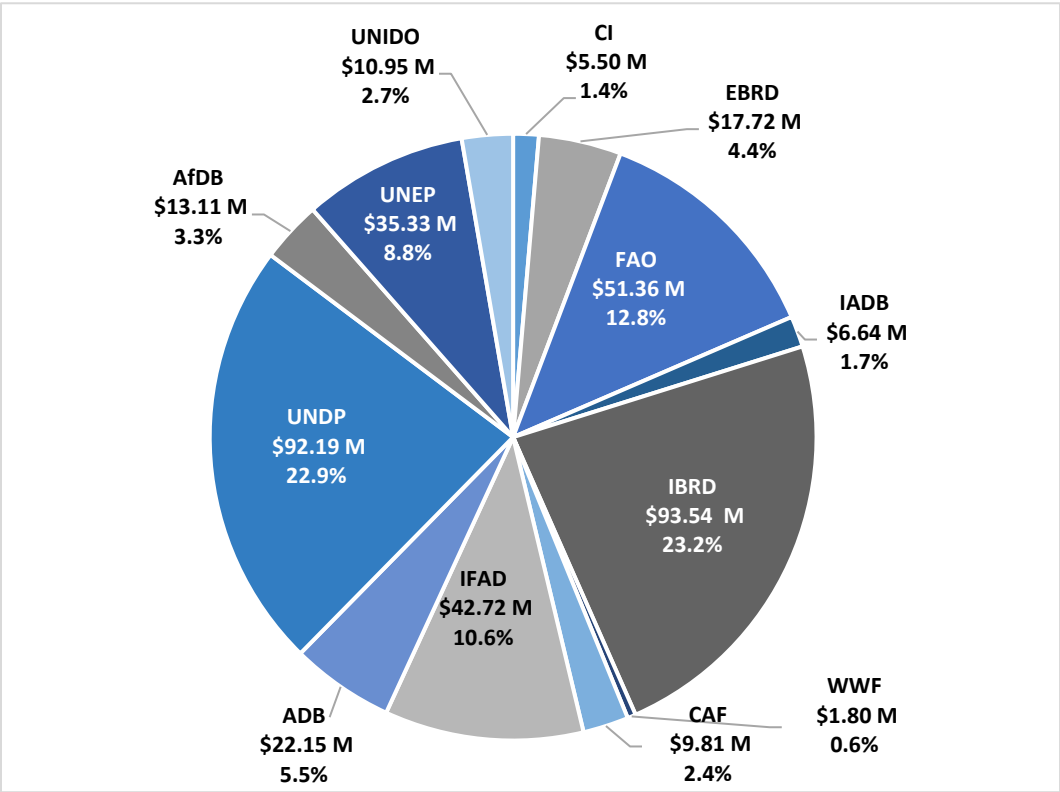
38. *Systemic Capital for Adaptation Localization and Expansion (SCALE)* (GEF ID: 11849, Global, Agency: CI, SCCF financing: \$1.12 million). This MSP is supported through the third round of the Challenge Program for Adaptation Innovation and is a good example of risk-appropriate SCCF window B support for a project with strong potential for scale up from other sources. The objective of the project is to scale climate adaptation solutions through investment vehicles including equity, credit, and technical assistance facilities. Building on the lessons learned from the first Climate Resilience and Adaptation Finance and Technology Transfer Facility (CRAFT), SCALE activities will support the launch of an up to \$700+ million SCALE strategy with an initial target of \$75 million entering due diligence for this project that would scale up capital mobilized, expand investment types, and increase investment sectors to health and support for nature and biodiversity. The project's components embrace transformation in the investment environment

(component 1), awareness creation to mobilize both public and private resources (Component 2), strengthening legal, governance and regulatory setup (component 3) and managing knowledge and stakeholder engagement (component 4). The project is expected to benefit 3.00 million people (50.0 percent female), strengthen 185 policies/plans for climate adaptation, train and raise the awareness 200 people (25.0 percent female) on climate change and engage 250 private sector enterprises in climate change adaptation and resilience action.

**Agency Involvement in SCCF Projects**

39. As of September 30, 2025, 13 GEF Agencies were involved in SCCF projects. The cumulative share of SCCF resources by MDBs and IFAD remains significant, currently totaling 51.1 percent of all resources. Since inception, based on information from the GEF portal, the World Bank continues to hold the largest share at 23.2 percent (\$93.54 million), followed closely by UNDP at 22.9 percent (\$92.19 million), FAO at 12.8 percent, IFAD at 10.6 percent, and UNEP at 8.8 percent, as shown in Figure 8.

**Figure 8: Distribution of Cumulative SCCF Financing by Agency, September 30, 2025 (\$ million)<sup>56</sup>**



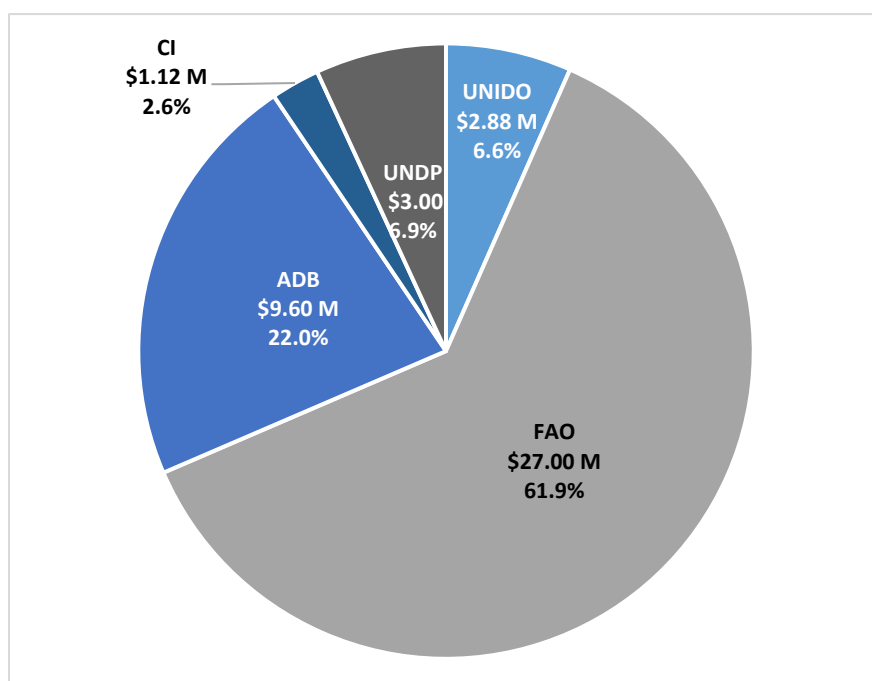
40. Following guidance of the Council and the GEF-8 policy recommendations, efforts are continuing to be made for balanced distribution of SCCF financing among Agencies including an aspirational ceiling for any one Agency of no more than 30.0 percent, and a target for the regional

multilateral banks and IFAD of 10.0 percent of the approved amounts. These targets are currently achieved for SCCF projects since inception.

41. In GEF-8, as of September 30, 2025, five GEF Agencies have had SCCF projects approved, of which 61.9 percent is with FAO, 22.0 percent with ADB, 6.9 percent with UNDP, for eight projects under SCCF window A, and 6.6 percent with UNIDO and 2.6 percent with CI for four projects under SCCF window B. There has been a steady reduction in the share of FAO from 63.6 percent during the previous reporting period to 61.9 percent due to the involvement of CI in this reporting period. The GEF Secretariat has also reiterated the Agency concentration concern to FAO and relevant countries, and this issue was also highlighted by some Council members in the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council. The GEF Secretariat continues to monitor the portfolio to ensure the 30.0 percent threshold per Agency is achieved.

### Expected Results under the SCCF

42. By the end of this reporting period, 103 of 105 SCCF projects have been endorsed or approved by the CEO.<sup>57</sup> Of these projects, 58 have completed implementation.<sup>58</sup>

43. Table 7 provides a summary of the quantitative results indicators from SCCF projects.<sup>59</sup> Full expected results are detailed in the results frameworks specific to each project, available in

the project documents posted on the GEF website.<sup>60</sup> In response to a request made at the 14<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council in June 2013, the Secretariat, in its Annual Monitoring Reviews of the LDCF and the SCCF, continues to provide a summary of actual portfolio-level results of projects.<sup>61</sup>

44. Projects approved for SCCF support aim to directly reduce the vulnerability of 12.53 million people. Furthermore, SCCF projects support countries in their efforts to develop or strengthen an estimated 781 policies, plans, and processes that identify, prioritize, and integrate climate change adaptation strategies and measures. Additionally, SCCF projects train an estimated 271,888 people to identify, prioritize, implement, monitor and/or evaluate adaptation strategies and measures.

45. Since the start of GEF-6 in July 2014, which is when LDCF/SCCF began systematically tracking sex disaggregated data, 2.96 million of the 6.09 million (48.6 percent) expected project beneficiaries of SCCF projects are female, and 46,163 of the 109,746 (42.1 percent) expected people trained are female.

46. The one-step MSP that was approved in the reporting period is expected to directly benefit 3.0 million people (50.0 percent women), strengthen climate adaptation in 185 policies or frameworks, and train 200 people (25.0 percent women).

### Sectoral Distribution

47. Each SCCF project focusses on one or more sectors. Figure 10 provides a breakdown of

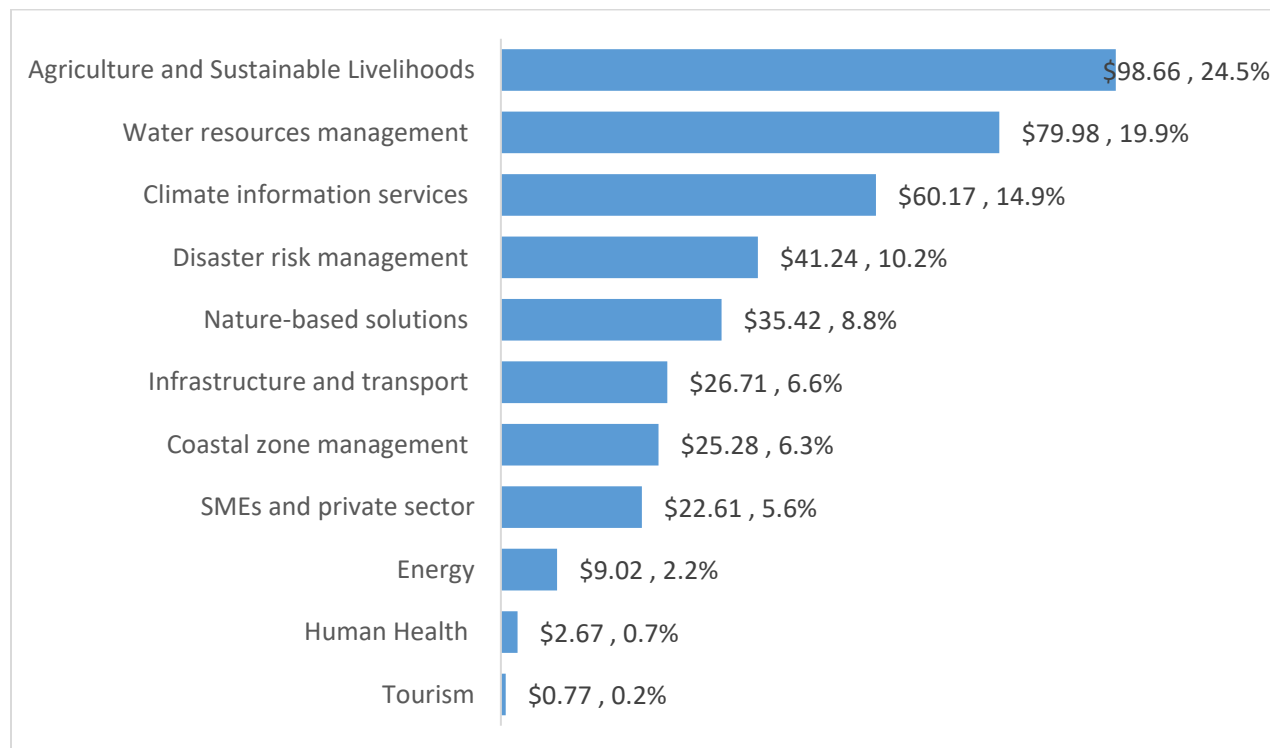

the cumulative sectoral focus on all SCCF projects since inception.<sup>67</sup> Agriculture, water, and climate information are the sectors with the largest investment among all SCCF projects, followed by disaster-risk management and nature-based solutions.

### **MULTI-TRUST FUND PROJECTS (MTFs)**

48. To date, there have been a total of 60 projects and programmatic approaches that draw resources from multiple trust funds involving the LDCF, GEF Trust Fund and/or SCCF. Of these 60 MTF projects, 10 draw resources from both the LDCF and SCCF, 35 draw from the LDCF and GEF Trust Fund, and 15 draw from the SCCF and GEF Trust Fund. Annex III presents a complete list of approved MTF projects to date.

49. Since the approval of the first MTF project in GEF-5, MTF projects and programs have accounted for 11.0 percent of the total number of the LDCF and the SCCF projects and programs. During the GEF-7 period, 23 MTF projects and programs were approved by the Council and/or the CEO, representing 27.1 percent of the total number of LDCF and SCCF projects and programs. In the current GEF-8 period, 16 MTFs have been approved to date, comprising 25.4 percent of the total number of LDCF and SCCF projects and programs.

50. The ability to advance integration and mainstreaming of adaptation with support from

across the GEF family of funds is a unique and valuable feature of the GEF, as this supports integration and synergies across climate and global environmental dimensions. The GEF Secretariat will continue its efforts to facilitate integrated programming as appropriate, taking into consideration national needs, opportunities for systemic impact, and programming priorities.

## **DEDICATED PROGRAMS**

51. The GEF-8 Programming Strategy includes Dedicated Programs, which are corporate programs that provide targeted support for communications and visibility enhancement, outreach and capacity support for country planning and programming with a focus on enabling access to finance, and organizational learning and coordination.

52. During this reporting period, activities related to the dedicated program on “Communications and Visibility Enhancements” have been focused on two main areas: the ongoing development of the GEF Programming Strategy on Adaptation to Climate (LDCF/SCCF Strategy), and support to key global events taking place in the closing quarter of 2025.

53. Communication and Knowledge Management aspects of the LDCF/SCCF Strategy have been refined in line with stakeholder and internal feedback, including to ensure alignment with the GEF-9 Communication Strategy, with a focus on effectively capturing and communicating the comparative advantage of the two funds, while concurrently supporting project-level communication capacity to effectively share the impact of the LDCF and SCCF at the national level.

54. At the time of reporting, efforts are underway to ensure an impactful GEF presence at several strategic global events, including the Adaptation Futures Conference 2025, UNFCCC COP 30, and the Seventh United Nations Environment Assembly – all of which provide key political and profiling opportunities for the LDCF and SCCF. In particular, active collaboration on communication with the other Multilateral Climate Funds (MCFs) has continued throughout the reporting period, with a focus on UNFCCC COP30 in Belem. The MCFs will host their third joint pavilion at COP30, with a schedule of over 35 events, including a joint public event with the heads of the Adaptation Fund, Climate Investment Funds, Green Climate Fund, the GEF, and the Fund for Responding to Loss and Damage.

55. Active collaboration with and ongoing GEF guidance to Implementing and Executing Agencies has contributed to a strong content footprint throughout the reporting period, including the publication of over 20 stories on GEF-funded climate change adaptation initiatives across national media, as well as GEF and partner channels.

56. With regards to the dedicated program of “Outreach and Capacity Support for Planning and Programming”, the series of sub-regional LDCF and SCCF programming workshops for LDCs and SIDS have been completed. In total, six workshops were delivered to enhance the knowledge of 69 countries on LDCF and SCCF programming, strengthen capacity of participants on climate change adaptation, and support country-led programming projects for LDCF and SCCF funding in the GEF-8 period.

57. As highlighted in the 2024 Annual Evaluation Report of the GEF Independent Evaluation Organization (IEO), the workshops led to improved capacity of countries in designing effective and durable adaptation projects in collaboration with the GEF Agencies, technical experts, the GEF Scientific and Technical Advisory Panel, and the UNFCCC. These sessions have also led to strong ownership and engagement of countries in the projects, which is expected to translate into durable outcomes.<sup>68</sup> Further, the Secretariat focused on emerging priority themes, such as social protection and fragility and conflict situations to build understanding and to enhance partnerships.

58. Regarding the dedicated program on “Organizational Learning and Coordination”, with 5,347 approved projects, the LDCF/SCCF portfolios provide a valuable resource of climate change adaptation experiences and learning. The objective of this Dedicated Program is to enable the fund and portfolio-level learning by creating, acquiring, and sharing knowledge and insights. This learning gained will drive ongoing programming and performance improvements of LDCF/SCCF.

59. Learning and knowledge sharing activities are being carried out at project and portfolio levels. For example, during this reporting period more than six in-person and virtual learning and knowledge sharing events were held by partners on topics related to climate adaptation innovation and private sector engagement of direct relevance to the GEF-8 Climate Change Adaption Strategy. These events are drawing on learning being gained from projects supported through the Challenge Program for Adaptation Innovation, as well as other projects supported by the LDCF and SCCF and others, and are supported by the project *Amplifying the Impact of the ‘Challenge Program for Adaptation Innovation’ through Learning and Knowledge Management* (GEF ID: 11303).

60. To further strengthen portfolio learning, the GEF Secretariate has initiated a review and analysis of LDCF and SCCF portfolios to date with the support of a consultant to identify and document key learning and recommendations for consideration in future programming. Initial analysis of learning from the LDCF and SCCF projects will be presented in the next 40<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council Meeting.

## **CHALLENGE PROGRAM FOR ADAPTATION INNOVATION**

61. The Challenge Program for Adaptation Innovation has continued to demonstrate its effectiveness in catalyzing innovation and private sector engagement for adaptation impact. The Challenge Program tests and validates potentially scalable, bankable, or otherwise fundable investment approaches, business models, partnerships, and technologies. It has been successful in engaging a range of new partners with whom the GEF has not yet been able to partner directly with through conventional programming.

62. During this reporting period, a comprehensive analysis of the projects supported, and insights gained to date through the first three rounds of this Challenge Program was presented

in an Information Document prepared for the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council.<sup>69</sup>

63. Also, during this reporting period, all the 13 highly innovative project concepts that were announced at UNFCCC COP29 as winners of the third round of this Challenge Program<sup>70</sup> have partnered with a GEF Agency to develop, seek approval, and implement an MSP with support of the LDCF and/or SCCF. At the time of writing, nine of the 13 projects have been submitted during this for approval as MSPs through the one-step approach. One project gained full CEO approval through the one step approach four and a half months after its initial submission, and started implementation shortly thereafter, which demonstrates the relative efficiency and relevance of this program to the urgency of the need and pace of private sector investment.

### **INCLUSIVE GEF ASSEMBLY CHALLENGE PROGRAM<sup>71</sup>**

64. The Inclusive GEF Assembly Challenge Program is an initiative funded by the SCCF and LDCF to demonstrate GEF's commitment to work with non-state actors in advancing its mission for a healthy planet and healthy people. The program was conceived to promote the inclusive nature of the Seventh GEF Assembly, held in 2023 in Vancouver, Canada. The overall aim of the program is to catalyze inclusive and innovative on-the-ground actions, implemented by non-state actors, including community based/civil society organizations in delivering inclusive climate resilience and environmental benefits for people and ecosystems, and advance the whole-of-society approach.

65. Since the approval of the two MSPs for this program, as outlined in the previous report to the 38<sup>th</sup> LDCF/SCCF Council Meeting, the implementation of the projects activities is ongoing. Most of the Winners have submitted their initial progress reports to UNIDO, and the details will be presented to the Council in the next reporting period.

66. During this reporting period, GEF Secretariat conducted a field monitoring visit to one of the initiatives being implemented in Kenya to assess its progress and meet the beneficiaries. Focusing on restoration of degraded land, this single initiative has mobilized and trained over 52 women who are now taking active roles in resources governance and land restoration practices and income generation through grass seed banks development, beekeeping, and village saving and loan association activities.

67. To strengthen the capacity of the Winners, enhance the visibility of the program and promote south-south learning, three of the Winners in collaboration with the Center for International Forestry Research (CIFOR-ICRAF) have organized a webinar on "*Innovative agroforestry systems in Africa: Challenges, techniques and right of trees outside forest in Africa*" in the sidelines of the 2025 IUCN World Congress. During this webinar, the Winners shared concrete experiences, innovative solutions and success stories from the implementation of their

project activities while stressing the impact the program is making on the livelihoods of the local communities. UNIDO is currently planning a side event to be held at the margin of its Climate Adaptation Week scheduled for February 2026 in Vienna, Austria, where all or selected Winners will participate and share their work, experience, success story, and establish partnership for scaling up their initiatives.

## OVERVIEW OF CONTRIBUTIONS, COST STRUCTURE AND VISIBILITY

68. Table 8 presented in this section provides an analysis on contribution levels and diversification in FY 2025, from April 1 to September 30, 2025. Table 9 provides an analysis of efficiency of cost structure in FY 2025. Table 10 provides data on visibility of the LDCF and SCCF in FY 2025.
