





Costs Analysis: -

Our experience show that most countries utilize the total funds approved under EAs modality.

1 FSP – South Africa for 4M

- 5 Years Project timeline 3 reports submitted to the UNFCCC. (2014 2019)
 - Out of US\$ 4,600,650 approved, appx. US\$
 2,298,487 disbursed to SA balance to be returned





NCS AND BURS ESTIMATED SUBMISSION TIMELINES & POTENTIAL OF NEW PROJECTS






- impacts of COVID 19 on projected timelines & 'moving targets' from respondents

Issues to consider: Continue raising awareness of project staff on BTR processes (if not negotiators)
Annual Survey 2020 questionnaire to cover BTRs assessment

Elements of training and technical support for BTRs

Greater effort for developing country
Parties to collect,
manage, and treat all the necessary data and information to fulfill the reporting requirements every two years (CBIT projects)

Enhanced GHG inventory - from summary GHG reports for BUR and NCs to preparation of detailed National Inventory Reports (NIR)

GHG emission/sequestration projections and mitigation assessment for NDC updating

NDC accounting and tracking of progress for transparent BTR reporting
