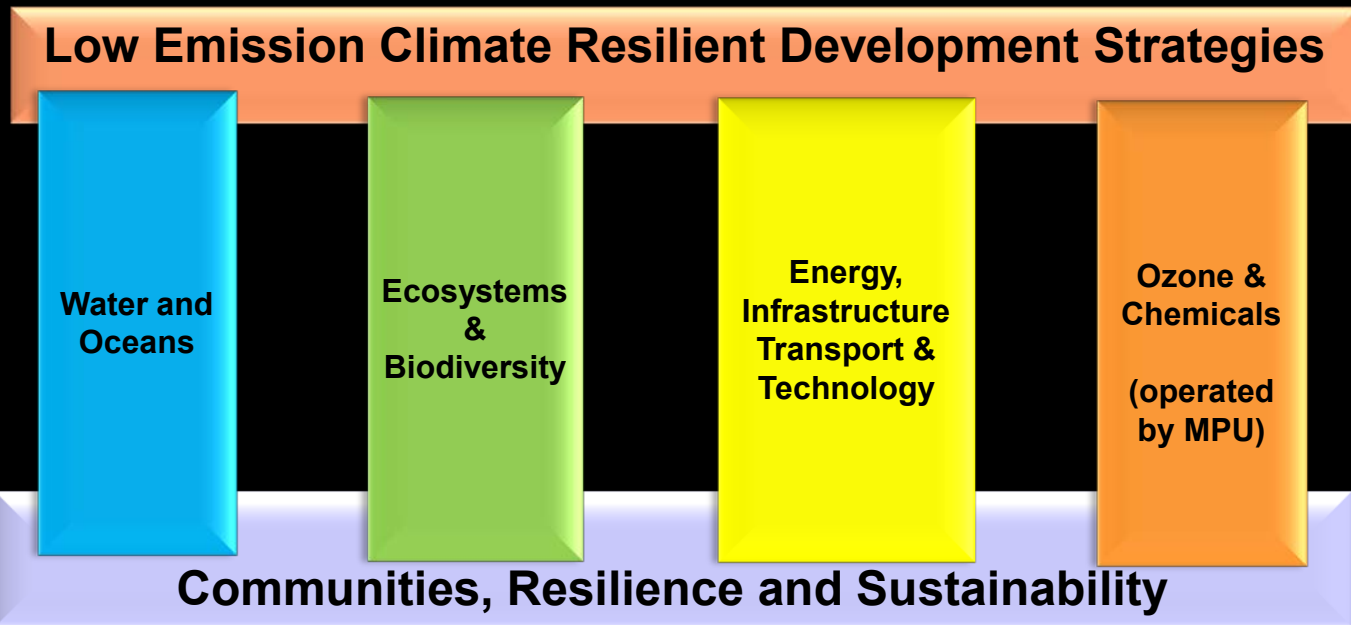

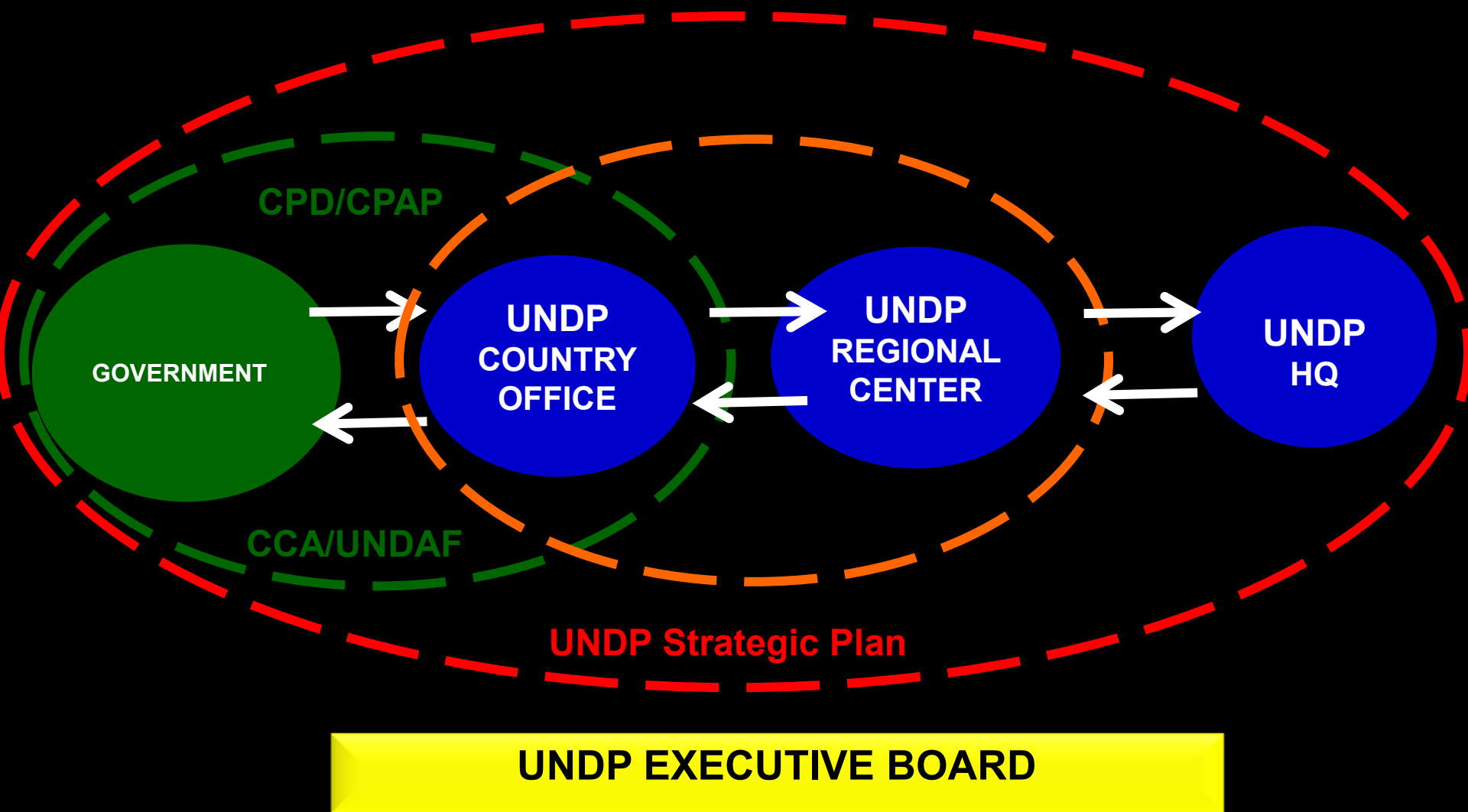
Assist developing countries to transition to green, inclusive, low emission and climate resilient development

Approach: Catalyzing environmental finance

UNDP-GEF team supports partner countries in **accessing a variety of vertical funds for global environment management** (GEF Trust Fund, Least Developed Countries Fund, Special Climate Change Fund; Adaptation Fund, Nagoya Protocol Implementation Fund), and combining this with other sources of public and private financing (domestic resources, carbon finance, bilateral vertical funds for global environment management, etc.).

This financing is used to develop capacity, remove policy and regulatory barriers, and expand/transform green markets in order to increase resilience, reduce poverty and make green, low emission climate resilient development possible.



Ecosystems and Biodiversity

OBJECTIVE

maintain and enhance the goods and services provided by biodiversity and ecosystems to secure livelihoods, food, water and health, enhance resilience, conserve threatened species and their habitats and increase carbon storage and sequestration.

Signature Programs

Integrating biodiversity and ecosystem management into development planning and production sector activities

Unlocking the potential of Protected Areas, including indigenous and community conserved areas, to contribute towards sustainable development

Managing and rehabilitating ecosystems for adaptation to and mitigation of CC





Green Low Emission Climate Resilient Development

OBJECTIVE

Develop the capacity of national and sub-national governments to conduct long-term integrated planning exercises to transition to green, low emission and climate resilient development

Signature Programs

Integrated Climate Change Strategies

Advancing Cross sectoral climate resilient livelihoods

Strengthening climate information and Early warning Systems for climate resilient development and adaptation to Climate Change.





Energy, Infrastructure, Transport and Technology

OBJECTIVE

Environmentally sustainable pathways for energy use and supply are adopted, and climate resilient infrastructure and low carbon transport and mobility options realised.

Access to clean and affordable energy

Low emission urban and transport infrastructure

Access to new finance mechanisms





Water & Ocean Governance

OBJECTIVE

To promote integrated, ecosystem-based, climate resilient management of the world's major freshwater and marine transboundary water systems through improved water and ocean governance.

Signature Programs

Sustainable management of oceans

Protection of transboundary surface and groundwater systems

Climate resilient integrated water resource and coastal management



OBJECTIVE:
 to reduce the risks to human health and the environment, particularly the poor, women and children from hazardous chemical substances and waste

Signature Programs

Reducing persistent organic pollutants (POPs) and mercury releases through the sound management of chemicals and hazardous waste, in sectors such as industrial, health, energy and agricultural

Phasing out ozone depleting substances and maximizing climate benefits of the HCFCs phase-out through the introduction and promotion of best technologies and practices.





Communities Resilience and Sustainability

OBJECTIVE:

Empower community organizations and networks to achieve inclusive, resilient and sustainable development and develop local solutions for global environment management

Signature Programs

Promote local solutions for the global environment through small grant projects

Promote community resilience through integrated landscape management

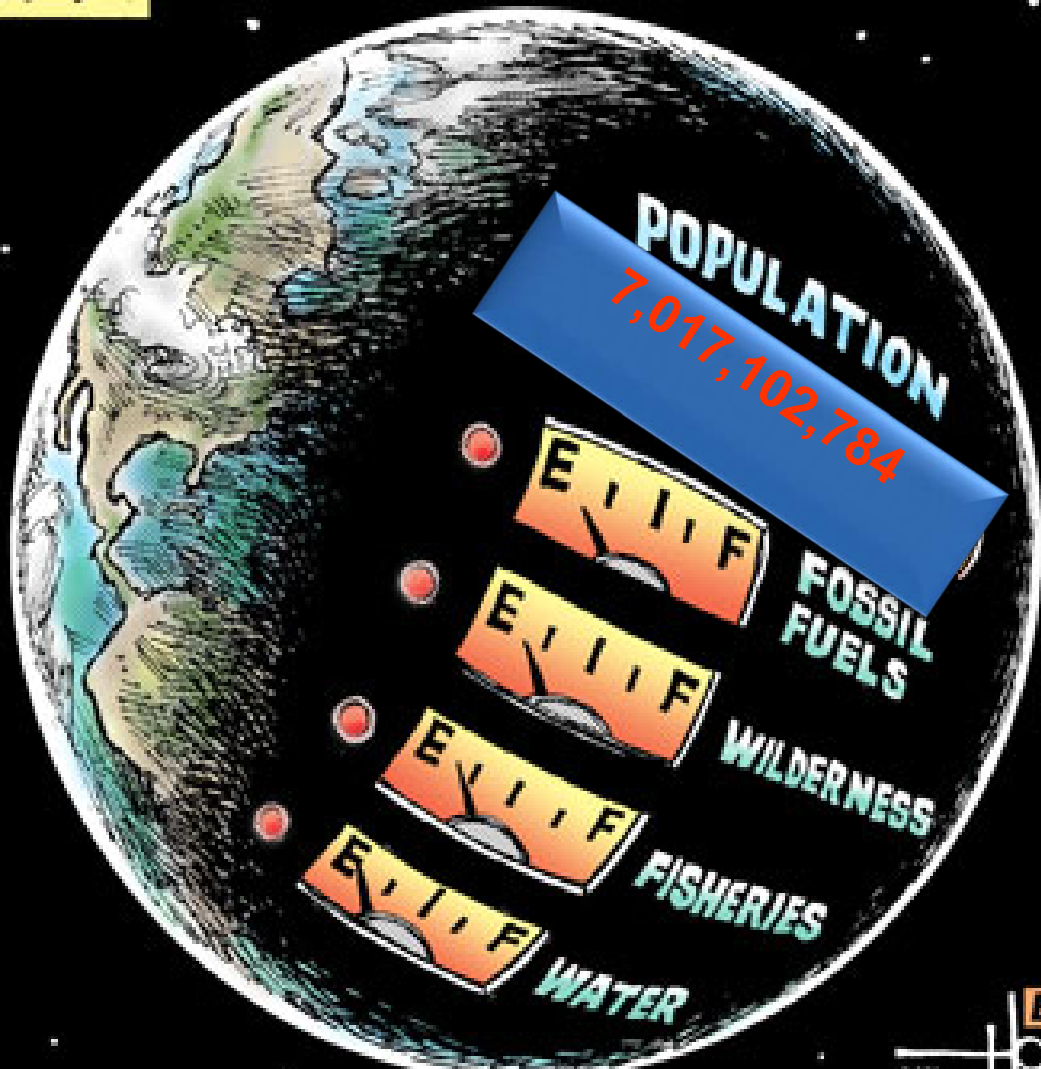
