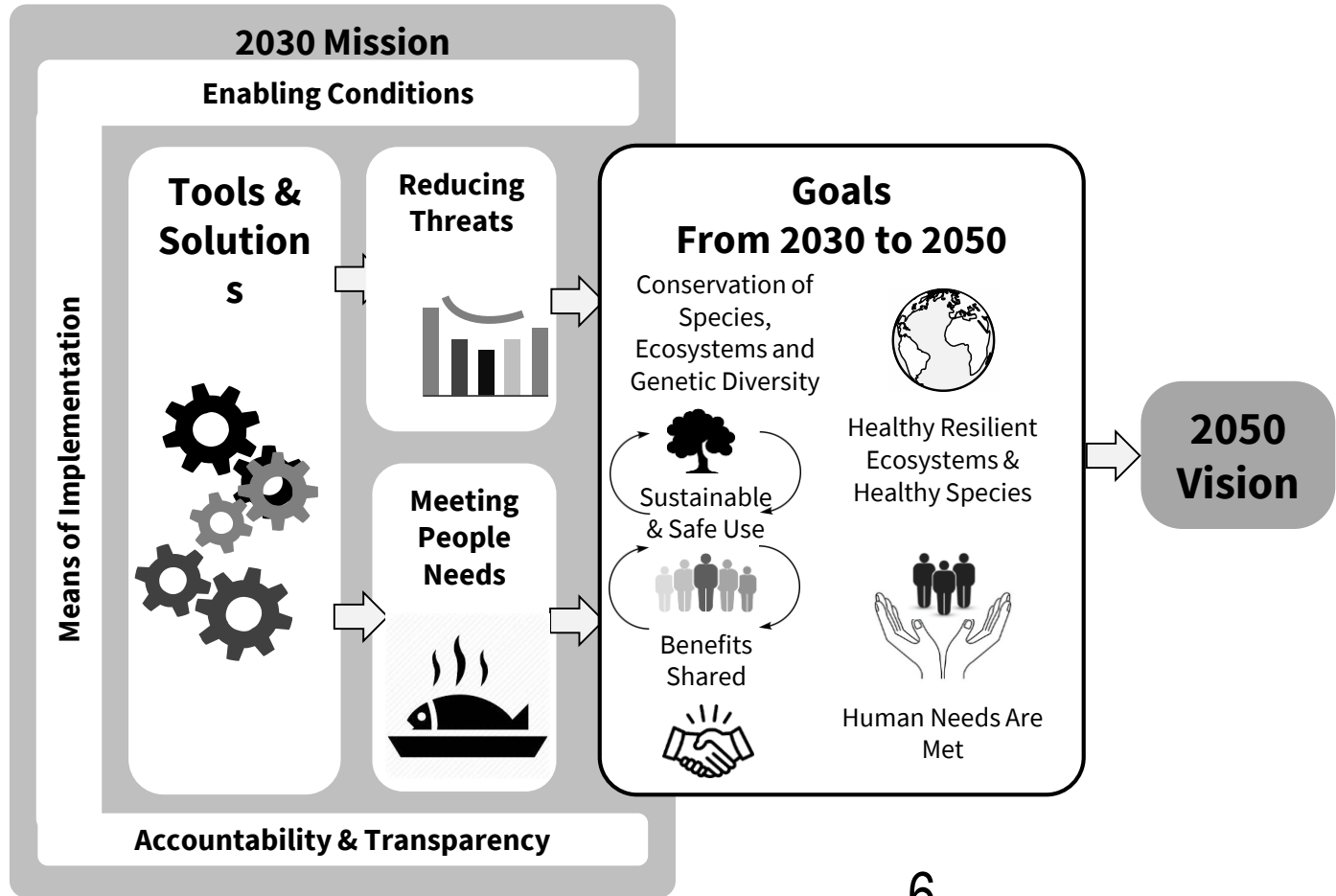



- The draft Global Biodiversity Framework document is **EVERGREEN**
  - First public draft to be released online on January 13, 2020 in all UN languages
- OEWG2 (February 2020)
  - First round of negotiations in Kunming, China
- OEWG3 (July 2020)
  - Formal approval of draft Global Biodiversity Framework in Cali, Colombia
- COP15 (October 2020)
  - Final approval of the new Global Biodiversity Framework in Kunming, China
