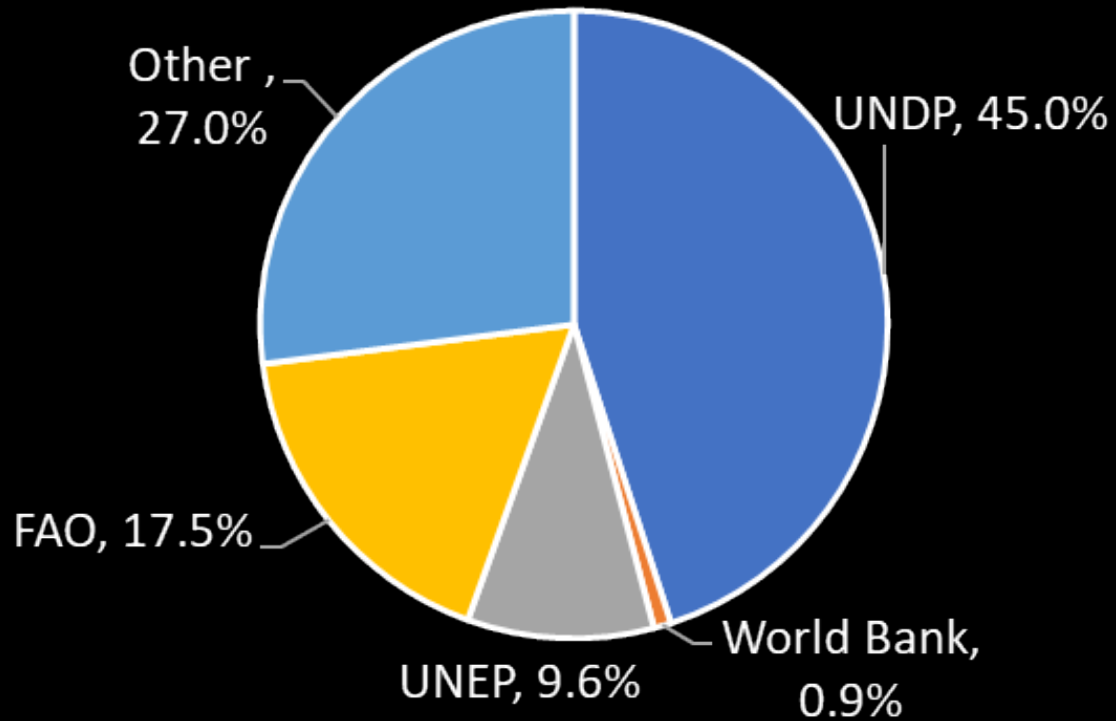

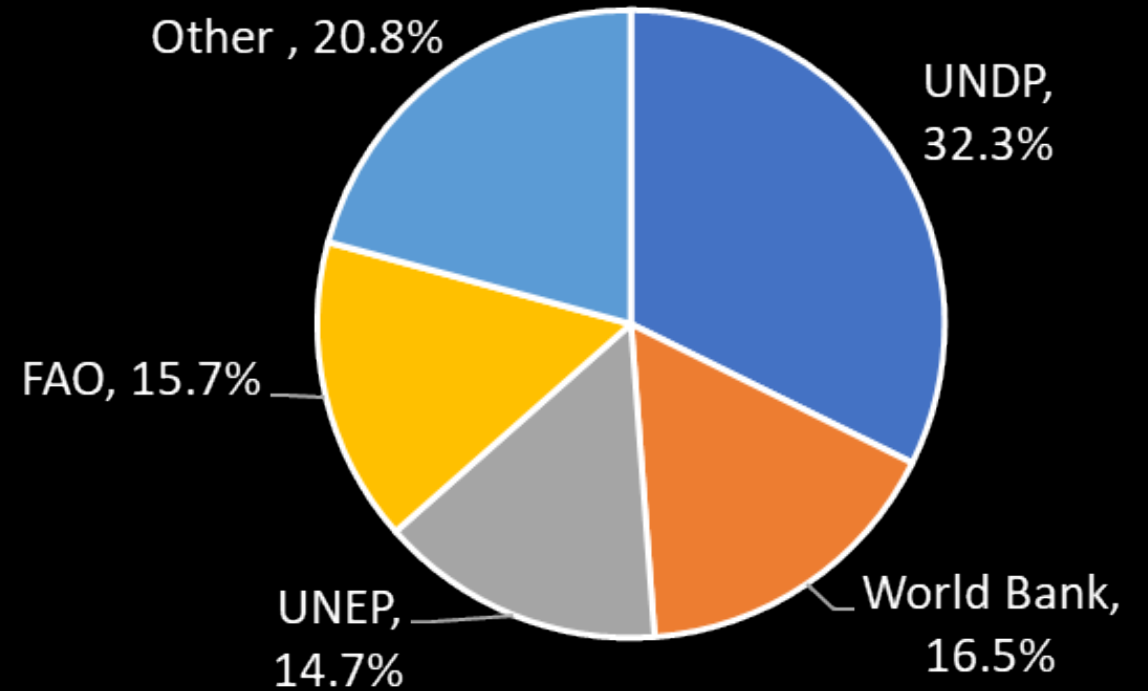

Distribution of Resources by Agency

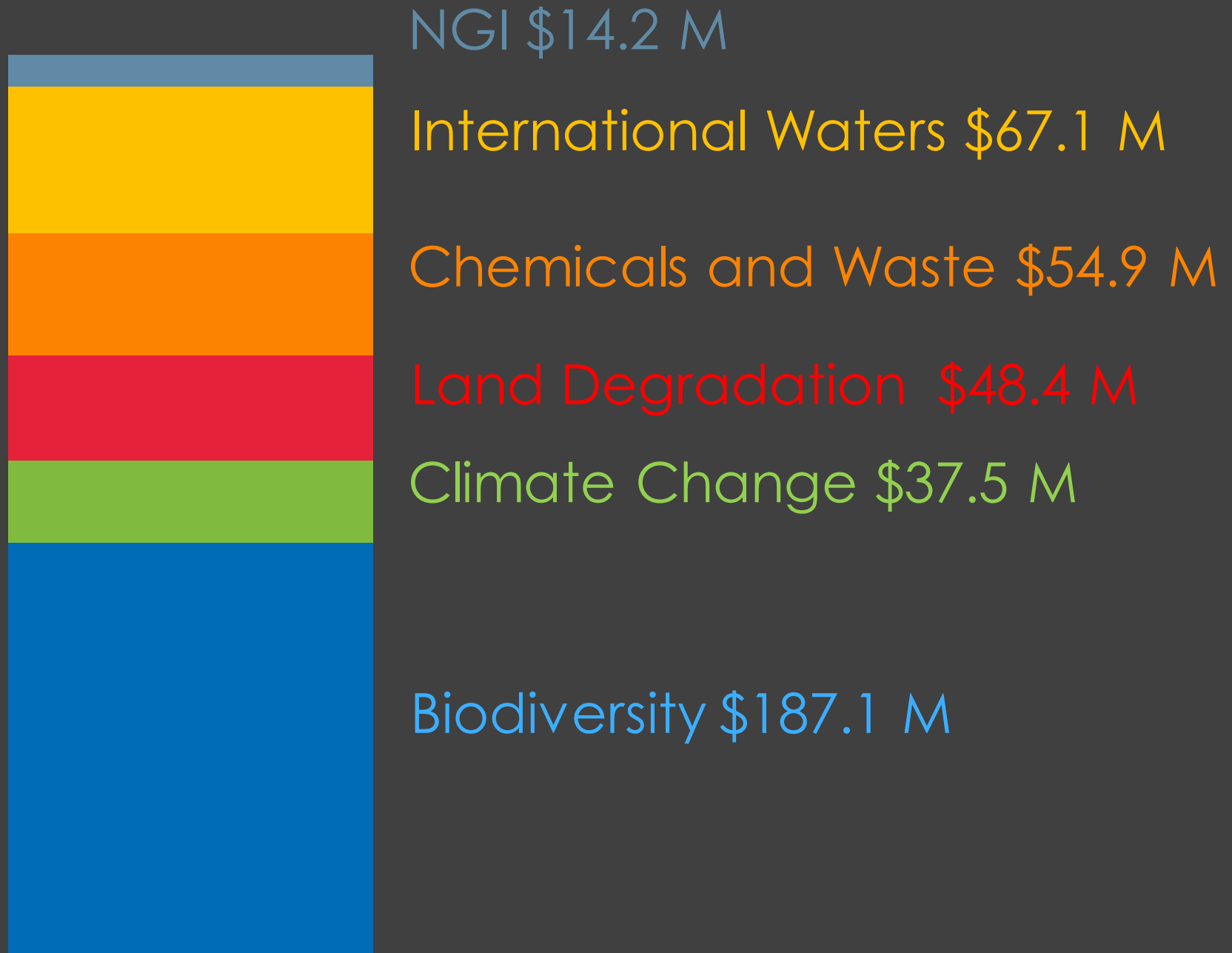

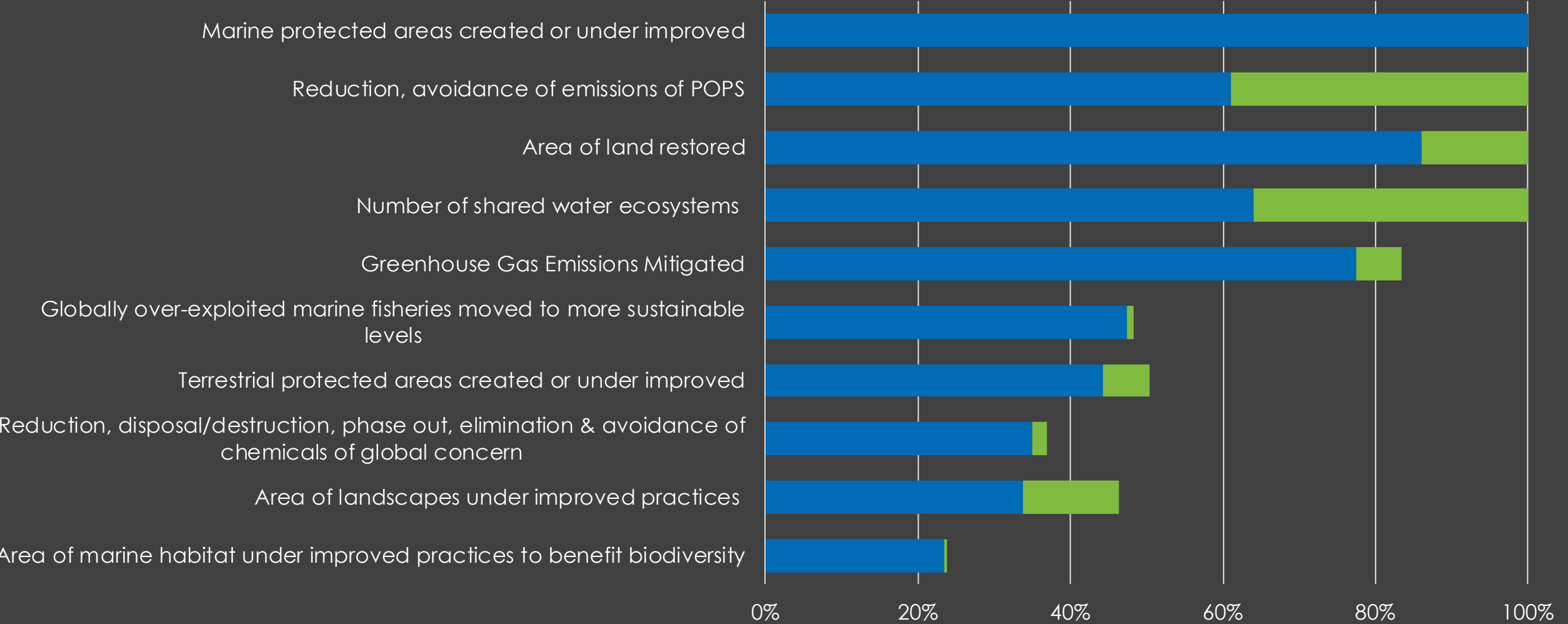

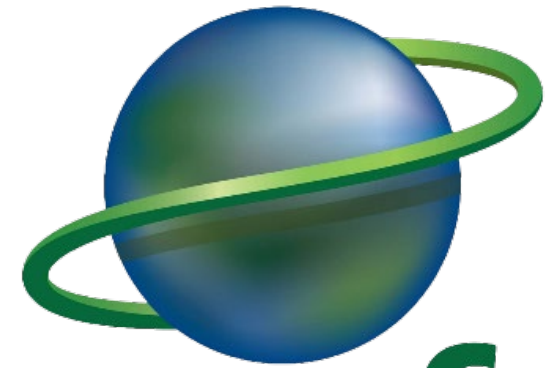
