Dear LDCF/SCCF Council Member:

This letter supersedes my letter of April 12, 2013 conveying the Council's approval of the April 2013 LDCF/SCCF Intersessional Work Program.

I take note that the Regional (Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Senegal): Senegal River Basin Climate Change Resilience Development Project is requested by Council to be circulated prior to CEO endorsement.

Hence, the approved decision, taking into account Council Members' comments, is amended and reads as follows:

The LDCF/SCCF Council reviewed the proposed work program posted on March 11, 2013, and approves the work program, comprising of the following two multi-trust fund Project Identification Forms (PIFs), subject to the comments submitted to the Secretariat by April 8, 2013:

Multi-Trust Fund Projects

- Regional (Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Senegal): Senegal River Basin Climate Change Resilience Development Project¹ (World Bank) (LDCF Project Grant: \$12,000,000)
- 2. **Ecuador:** Promotion of Climate-Smart Livestock Management Integrating Reversion of Land Degradation and Reduction of Desertification Risks in Vulnerable Provinces² (FAO) (SCCF Grant: \$1,462,083)

This is a multi-trust fund project drawing funds from two sources – the GEF Trust Fund and the Special Climate Change Fund. Only the SCCF component is presented here. For the entire project, refer to Annex C in the work program cover note.

This is a multi-trust fund project drawing funds from two sources – the GEF Trust Fund and the Least Developed Countries Fund. Only the LDCF component is presented here. For the entire project, refer to Annex C in the work program cover note.

With respect to the Regional (Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Senegal): Senegal River Basin Climate Change Resilience Development Project approved as part of the work program, the Council requested the Secretariat to arrange for Council Members to receive draft final project documents at least four weeks prior to the CEO's endorsing the project document for final approval by the GEF Agency to provide Council Members the opportunity to transmit to the CEO any concerns they may have.

With respect to Ecuador: Promotion of Climate-Smart Livestock Management Integrating Reversion of Land Degradation and Reduction of Desertification Risks in Vulnerable Provinces, the Council finds that this PIF (i) is, or would be, consistent with the Instrument and GEF/LDCF/SCCF policies and procedures and (ii) may be endorsed by the CEO for final approval by the GEF Agency, provided that the final project document fully incorporates and addresses the Council's and the STAP reviewer's comments on the work program, and that the CEO confirms that the project continues to be consistent with the Instrument and GEF/LDCF/SCCF policies and procedures.

With respect to any PIF approved in this work program, the final project document will be posted on the GEF website for information after CEO endorsement. If the GEF CEO determines that there have been major changes to the project scope and approach since PIF approval, the final project document shall be posted on the web for Council review for four weeks prior to CEO endorsement.

Beginning in this work program, the new procedure for tranche fee payment will apply to all projects in which 40% of the Agency fees are committed upon approval of this work program and the remaining 60% at CEO endorsement. The detailed funding decisions taken by the Council is appended as Annex 1.
